If you have any immediate questions, please do not hesitate to reach out to your assigned regional grant specialist.

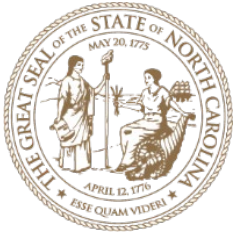

Subject: Special Initiative ConCPT Program Funding Opportunity

Good morning Transit Partners,

The Integrated Mobility Division (IMD) is pleased to announce a Call for Projects for the Special Initiative ConCPT Program. This opportunity is open to all transit systems and supports Consolidation and Coordination projects aimed at improving efficiencies and enhancing transportation services across North Carolina.

This Special Initiative is 100% state-funded and expands the existing ConCPT program by:

- Reducing the required number of program participants
- Expanding eligible participants and activities
- Allowing select capital expenditures under the Coordination grant

The period of performance is July 1, 2026 – June 30, 2027.

Funding awards will be based on project scope and estimated costs, with a maximum of \$200,000 per entity. IMD will reimburse 100% of eligible project costs with appropriate documentation. Applicants may apply for this funding in multiple years, subject to continued availability.

Application Requirements:

1. EBS Special Initiative Application:
 - P2027_SPEC_CONCPT_CN (Consolidation)
 - P2027_SPEC_CONCPT_CO (Coordination)
2. Completed FY27 Special Initiative ConCPT Written Application
3. FY27 Master Documents (from prior FY27 5311 application or newly completed)
4. Additional supporting documents (per application checklist)
5. Completed FY27 Special Initiative ConCPT Application Checklist

*Note, the ConCPT application requires a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) or Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between participants. Due the potential amount of time required to complete an MOA or MOU, IMD will accept and review projects without the MOA or MOU but will require it to be submitted prior to the completion of an agreement.
