In the new FY24 OpStats report, we have asked you to report brokered Medicaid trips separately from non-brokered Medicaid trips for the first time and there have been a few questions about this. On the OpStats report, for the Weekday, Saturday, and Sunday tabs each mode now has two lines for Medicaid trips. The 'Medicaid Contract' line that has always been there should now only include non-brokered Medicaid trips, i.e. sent by your local DSS. Trips sent by the brokers, i.e. ModivCare and/or MTM, should now be reported separately on the line labeled 'Brokered Medicaid'. The sum of the 'Medicaid Contract" and the "Brokered Medicaid Contract" trips should add up to the total Medicaid trips provided for each month.

We will be reaching out to your software vendors and asking them to update the internal OpStats report to split these out for you so that this will be automatically done for you for the FY25 report.
