\*\*The FY26 Combined Capital application will be opened in EBS later in the month of July to allow time for replacement vehicle information to be added for each system. A separate notification will be made when this application is available.

**\*\*New** - Small Urban systems interested in applying for a 5310 Operating grant are required to complete the application package and all supporting documentation, including the Master Documents. This application package and Master Documents package are available on the IMD Connect site, UGA webpage. The link is below. 5310 Operating grants are for projects (trips) designed for elderly and/or disabled passengers and not to offset or supplement normal operational expenses. The application due date is October 4, 2024. If a grant is approved, the Small Urban system is subject to a compliance review by IMD.

The EBS grant applications (UGA Phase 2) open period is **July 1 – October 4, 2024**. **All applications and any additional required documentation are due in EBS on or before Friday, October 4<sup>th</sup>**. **Quick Reference Guides** have been posted to the [UGA webpage](#) under

the News and Updates headline to assist with questions on Phase 2.

Completing the requirements of the Pre-registration Phase is necessary to advance to Phase 2. If you haven't completed the pre-registration, please download the UGA program from the Unified Grants Application webpage on IMD's Connect site and contact your assigned [Regional Grant Specialist](#) to complete your registration.
