It prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, and national origin in programs and activities receiving federal financial assistance. This 3-hour virtual course covers the Title VI historical overview, requirements under Title VI, and the Components of a Title VI Program. Staff from the NC Department of Civil Rights will be available to answer questions about demographic data and NC-specific requirements. The target audience for this training is Transit Directors and/or Compliance Officers for Rural systems (subrecipients of NCDOT-IMD).
