

# **Commercial Lift Training Syllabus & Schedule**

## **DPA, NL500 & NUVL Products**

All field training classes consisting of 10 people or fewer will primarily be hands on with classroom instruction only as necessary. Classes consisting of 11 people or more will be broken down in to two parts; classroom instruction and hands on instruction. In both cases the following core subjects will be taught (when applicable to the product at hand):

1. Product identification & operation.
2. Product manual, operator's video and other resource location.
3. Basic electrical connections & components.
4. Electrical troubleshooting and diagnostics.
5. Hydraulic system ID & troubleshooting.
6. Mechanical adjustments.
7. Maintenance procedures.

It is the responsibility of the customer to provide a clean and quiet location to host the classes. When necessary a projector screen or wall along with tables and chairs should be available. The hands on aspect of our classes is very important and it will be necessary for the customer to supply a sample lift product for us to demonstrate on. We request that product be in good working order when at all possible.

All students will be provided with any written training material applicable to the products we are instructing on.

Certificates of completion can be provided upon the customer's request.

Total training time will last approximately 3 hours but will depend on class size, type & number of product, breaks, etc. We are accommodating and flexible with the customers schedule as much as possible and will work with them beforehand to finalize any training class.
