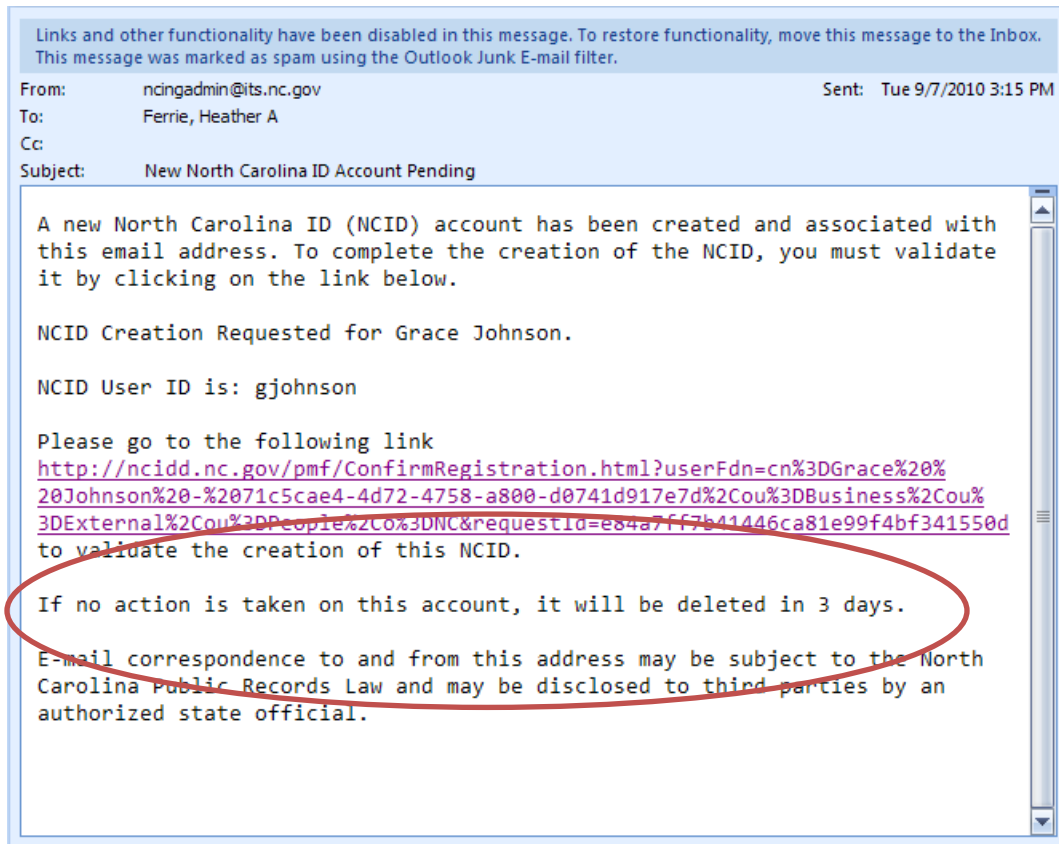


Getting into the NCDOT-PTD Training Toolkit

- 1) Sign up for an **NCID** (directions attached) <https://ncid.nc.gov> ****make sure you activate your account within 3 days of receiving your confirmation email from NCID.**



- 2) Send your NCID **UserID** – not password, to NCDOT so your ID can have access created; or forward your NCID account confirmation: currently tmontanez@ncdot.gov or your MDS.
- 3) You should be able to access the Training Toolkit within 2 days at the following link <https://connect.ncdot.gov/site/PTD-Training-Toolkit/>

Things I've learned:

- Currently Internet Explorer will not work with the Training Toolkit site, you will need Google **Chrome** or Mozilla **Firefox**
- When you sign in to the PTD Training Toolkit site you may need to use **ncid** at the front of your personal NCID
- If you signed up for an NCID several months ago, you will need to go back to the NCID site and reset your password for it to work. The site should take you through the steps. <https://ncid.nc.gov> (NCID user guide is attached)
- If you do not **validate** your NCID UserID (see email above) your account will not exist, please make sure you

- If you can't remember your NCID, you will need to go to that site for information or contact their help desk – we do not have access to that system from NCDOT.

How to get an NCID – Please forward your NCID (not password) to me so I can get your access to the Training Toolkit set up. You will not be able to get into the Toolkit site until I submit your NCID. Thanks!

You will need to **register** for a new account (the blue line) – register for an **individual account**; when you have your NCID/UserId forward that to me so I can have your access set up by NCODT. Please allow about 2 days for the access. (You may want to set up one account for the system, just make sure you do it as an individual account.)

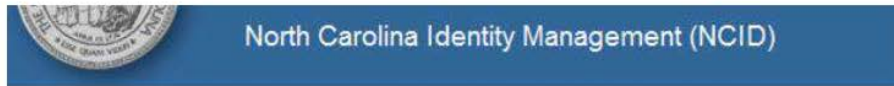
