

Finance Updates

- Final claims are due in EBS on or before July 30, 2023, for all projects ending on June 30, 2023. Please check the period of performance on all of your open projects and submit your claims asap.
- You must submit a change request to balance all budgets prior to submitting final claims in EBS. Any claims we receive in overdraft, will be returned for correction.
- IMD completed a blanket extension for all CARES and ARPA projects. The new end date on these projects is June 30, 2024. You do not need to submit a period of performance request for these projects.
- Finance will begin sending out FY24 contracts via DocuSIgn for all State programs to include: Urban State Match, Advanced Technology, Concpt, Rural State Operating (1st round), Rideshare and Traveler's Aid

ROAP Update Continued

- Upcoming Reporting Dates:
 - April 2023 ROAP report is due June 15th
 - May 2023 ROAP report is July 15th
 - June 2023 ROAP report is due on or before July 31st
- The end of year reconciliation of ROAP reports will begin in July, if past reports need to be corrected or submitted, please advise as soon as possible.
 - RGSs will reach out to systems who have not submitted reports through the fiscal year or who have not corrected or revised a ROAP report and resubmitted them.
 - These actions are necessary to complete the reconciliation at the end of the fiscal year.



Rural State Operating Overview

- 2nd Call for Projects opened April 24, 2023
- Funding available \$6,876,600
- Projects received totaled \$11,576,466
- Due to the amount requested, reductions were required
- All requests up to \$100,000 were funded at 100%
- Requests over \$100,000 were funded at the first \$100,000 and then at 70% of the remaining balance
- Multiple G-codes were available for this grant:
 - G-251 (Fuel and Lube)
 - G-252 (Tires and Tubes)
 - G-313 (Trips)
- If a request had all 3 eligible G codes requested, only G-313 was approved because G-313 uses a trip rate that should include the others

 - Systems who have been approved for NCDOT/FTA funding in FY23 may now look to order vehicles utilizing this
 contract

 - Make sure that the vehicle type you are ordering matches the G-code in your approved agreement

NCDOT Technology RFP


- NCDOT Agency Specific RFP for "Transit Software Solutions" closes on 6/19/23
 - Soliciting for proposals related, but not limited to:
 - · Transit scheduling software
 - Automated fare payment solutions
 - · Microtransit services
 - Automatic vehicle location (AVL)
- Once RFP closes, the evaluation committee will look to review proposals and put together a shortlist of vendors for further demonstrations and product assessments
- Contract should be awarded prior to close of calendar year 2023
- Systems with approved funding sources/grants may look to potentially use this contract in the future to help procure transit software contracts or products



Compliance Updates

2023 Compliance Reviews

- In 2023, we will cover 51 Compliance Reviews
 - 30 5310 Non-Profit Reviews (will begin in May/June)
 - 21 5311 Transit System Reviews (Will begin in the Fall)





Training Information

- Training Survey Survey link was sent via email on 6/7/23
 - Surveys can be completed by more than one person per agency.
 - The survey will take 15-30 minutes to complete depending on the level of input on open-ended questions.
 - This is a <u>mandatory survey</u>. There must be at least one response from every 5311 and/or 5310 subrecipient.
 - Survey will be open until COB on <u>June 21st, 2023</u>
- PASS Training IMD will be offering in-person PASS training classes.
 - Multiple opportunities in different locations across the state, dates are TBD.
 - If you have a facility that can accommodate up to 20 participants, and can have 2 vehicles available to do hands-on training, e-mail Kevin Edwards @ kbedwards2@ncdot.gov to offer your location. This will help get class locations determined and dates can then be set for the training.
 - Train the Trainer, initial certification class, not recertification classes.




