Transit Agency	Project Description
AppalCART	Provide coordinated transportation between Appalachian State University campuses, shopping areas, medical centers, residences, and dining locations.
Carteret County	Operate the Down East Express, a weekday commuter service connecting eastern North Carolina counties to the Raleigh-Durham area, including medical centers and the airport.
Columbus County	Columbus and Bladen counties will coordinate trips to Brunswick, New Hanover, Robeson, and Cumberland counties to destinations including medical facilities and shopping to increase efficiency, reduce duplicative services and expand transit opportunities.
Craven County	Provide coordinated transportation to Pitt County for access to medical centers, VA hospitals, educational facilities and other destinations.
Davidson County	Establish new routes connecting Davidson County Transportation and Winston-Salem Transit Authority at three locations.
Hyde County	The Ocracoke Express runs between Hatteras and Silver Lake Harbor in Ocracoke Village in alignment with the passenger ferry schedule to reach shops, restaurants, accommodations and attractions.
Macon County	Project 1: Launch the WNC Express, a regional route connecting western North Carolina counties to Asheville. Destinations include medical and VA centers, shopping areas, the bus station and the airport. Project 2: Expand Saturday transit service within Franklin town limits from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and provide transportation during designated special events.
Moore County	Provide reliable, ongoing trips to Sandhill Community College in Moore and Hoke counties.
Piedmont Authority for Regional Transportation (PART)	Implement a regional fare collection system that will allow riders to travel across all five transit systems using a single account and wallet balance.
Pitt County	Pitt County will provide Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant paratransit throughout the City of Greenville to supplement the city's fixed route services.

Rutherford County	Establish coordinated public transportation service connecting Rutherford and Polk counties and ICC campuses in Spindale and Columbus counties.
Sampson County	Project 1: Provide daily scheduled transportation service to Fayetteville, including access to the airport, major medical facilities, the Social Security Administration and verified addresses within city limits. Project 2: Provide reliable daily transportation for residents traveling to classes and programs at Sampson Community College.
Stanly County	Collaboration between Stanly and Montgomery counties will allow residents access to additional cities, medical providers, and airports.
Swain County	Project 1: Improve regional mobility and expand access to educational, employment, and medical destinations. Project 2: Expand transportation access to the Nantahala community in Macon County, which currently has no public transportation service.
Union County	Coordinate service between Union and Anson counties to Charlotte area destinations including various employers, and medical facilities.
WAVE Transit - Cape Fear Public Transit	Consolidate WAVE Transit and New Hanover County transportation services into a coordinated model to improve efficiency, align resources and provide ADA-compliant medical transportation.
