## Stroke - facts

- Every 40 seconds, someone in the United States has a stroke.
- Every 3 minutes and 11 seconds, someone dies of stroke in this country.
- Occurs when blood flow to part of the brain is cut off or bleeding into the brain.
- 38% of people hospitalized for stroke were less than 65 years old.
- Every year, more than 800,000 people in the United States have a stroke.

## Stroke: FAST

- F: Face- weakness, numbness
- A: Arm- weakness, numbness in one arm
- S: Speech-Slurred speech or difficulty speaking
- . T: Time- is critical

- · Ask the person to smile
- · Ask person to raise arms
- Ask the person to repeat something that you say
- · Call 911 right away
