Third-Party Escort Vehicle Operator Course Instructor General Information and Instructions

North Carolina requires third-party Escort Vehicle Operator course instructors to be certified to train and certify escort drivers pursuant to the rules issued by the Department, in accordance with G.S. 20-119 and 19A NCAC 02D .0644. Failure to maintain the conditions set forth by the Department will immediately result in revocation of instructor certification.

Qualifications:

- 1. At least 4 years of experience as a North Carolina Certified Escort Vehicle Operator;
- 2. Possess an active North Carolina Escort Vehicle Operator Certification;
- 3. Possess a valid driver's license without restrictions other than for the use of corrective lenses and shall not have received a citation in the previous 12 months for operating a vehicle in a reckless manner or driving while impaired; and
- 4. A licensed business owner or an employee of a licensed business which provides the Department's instructional training program for NC escort certifications

Instructions:

- 2. Submit "Third-Party Escort Vehicle Operator Course Training and Certification Instructor Application form
- 3. Submit the company Business License or Articles of Incorporation, if applicable.

Incomplete applications will not be accepted. No walk-in service is available. Upon receipt of these items, the Oversize/Overweight Permit Unit will issue the Third-Party EVO Instructor Certification after verifying that the applicant meets the criteria determined by the Department.
