CONTRACT TIME AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

7-1-95

The date of availability for this contract is July 1, 2002.

The completion date for this contract is November 1, 2003.

When observation periods are required by the special provisions, they are not a part of the work to be completed by the completion date and/or intermediate contract times stated in the contract. Should an observation period extend beyond the final completion date, the acceptable completion of the observation period shall be a part of the work covered by the performance and payment bonds.

The liquidated damages for this contract are Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) per calendar day. SP1G10

INTERMEDIATE CONTRACT TIME NUMBER 1 AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

The Contractor shall not narrow or close a lane of traffic on -L- (NC 135), detain and/or alter the traffic flow on or during holidays, holiday weekends, special events, or any other time when traffic is unusually heavy, including the following schedules:

HOLIDAY AND HOLIDAY WEEKEND LANE CLOSURE RESTRICTIONS:

- 1. For **New Year's Day**, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. December 31st and 7:00 a.m. January 2nd. If New Year's Day is on Saturday or Sunday, then until 7:00 a.m. the following Tuesday.
- 2. For Easter, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. Thursday and 7:00 a.m. Monday.
- 3. For Memorial Day, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. Friday and 7:00 a.m. Tuesday.
- 4. For **Independence Day**, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. the day before Independence Day and 7:00 a.m. the day after Independence Day.
 - If Independence Day is on a Saturday or Sunday, then between the hours of 4:00 p.m. the Thursday before Independence Day and 7:00 a.m. the Tuesday after Independence Day.
- 5. For Labor Day, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. Friday and 7:00 a.m. Tuesday.
- 6. For **Thanksgiving Day**, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. Tuesday and 7:00 a.m. Monday.

PROJECT SPECIAL PROVISIONS Utility

UTILITY CONFLICTS:

General:

The following utility companies have facilities that will be in conflict with the construction of this project:

- A. Duke Power
- B. Sprint
- C. Time Warner CATV
- D. NUI North Carolina Gas

The conflicting facilities unless otherwise noted will be adjusted prior to the date of availability and are therefore listed in these special provisions for the benefit of the Contractor. All utility work listed herein will be done by the utility owners. All utilities are shown on the plans from the best available information.

The Contractor's attention is directed to Article 105.8 of the Standard Specifications.

Utilities Requiring Adjustment:

A. Duke Power

- 1. See "Utility Conflict Plans" for utility conflicts.
- 2. Note: Duke will do the clearing for their relocation and will complete relocating by 9-20-02.

B. Sprint

- 1. See "Utility Conflict Plans" for utility conflicts.
- 2. Note: Sprint will be relocated by 11-15-02.

C. Time Warner CATV

- 1. See "Utility Conflict Plans" for utility conflicts for overhead CATV on power poles.
- Note: Existing underground CATV to remain and be adjusted where necessary. Contractor to give two weeks notice and two weeks for CATV to be moved.
