



State Transportation Innovation Council (STIC) Incentive Program

FY 2026 Application

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) State Transportation Innovation Council (STIC) Incentive Program provides technical assistance and up to \$125,000 in total funds per state each fiscal year to offset the costs of standardizing innovative practices. The program funds activities such as conducting internal assessments, initiating capacity building, developing guidance, drafting standards and specifications, organizing peer exchanges, and implementing system process changes. At the state level, the North Carolina Transportation Innovation Council (NC-TIC) determines which projects or activities to fund. The application for FY 2026 funding is open until April 17, 2026.

You must complete this application once you start it. Only applications submitted through this form will be evaluated.

Once the application closes, submissions will be evaluated by the NC-TIC. Applicants may be asked to present to the NC-TIC in June 2026. Awards will be announced in July 2026 with funding made available by October 2026.

Please note: the STIC Incentive Program requires a 20% non-Federal match from another funding source. You will be asked about the source for matching funds in the application.
