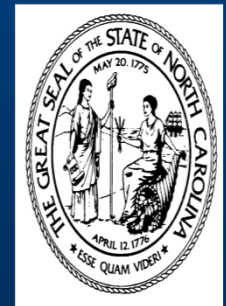
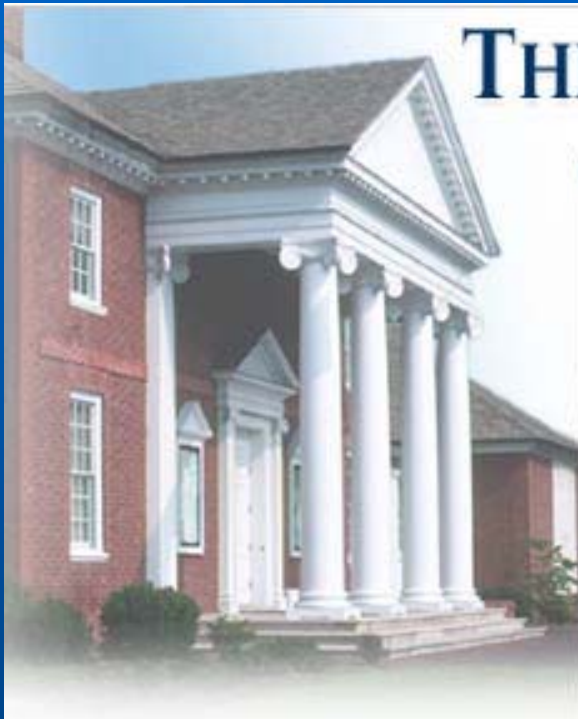
- Certain minor offenses which were decriminalized in 1986 (are not punishable by imprisonment)

- Remain separate, but come together as needed (for record checks/name searches, calendaring, and interfacing with other systems).

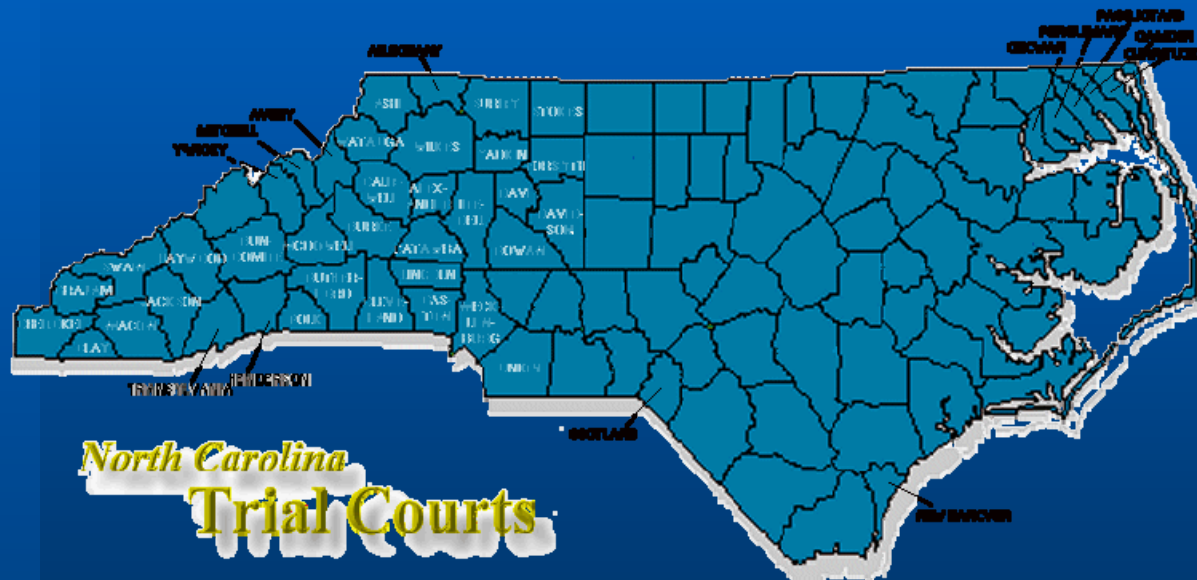

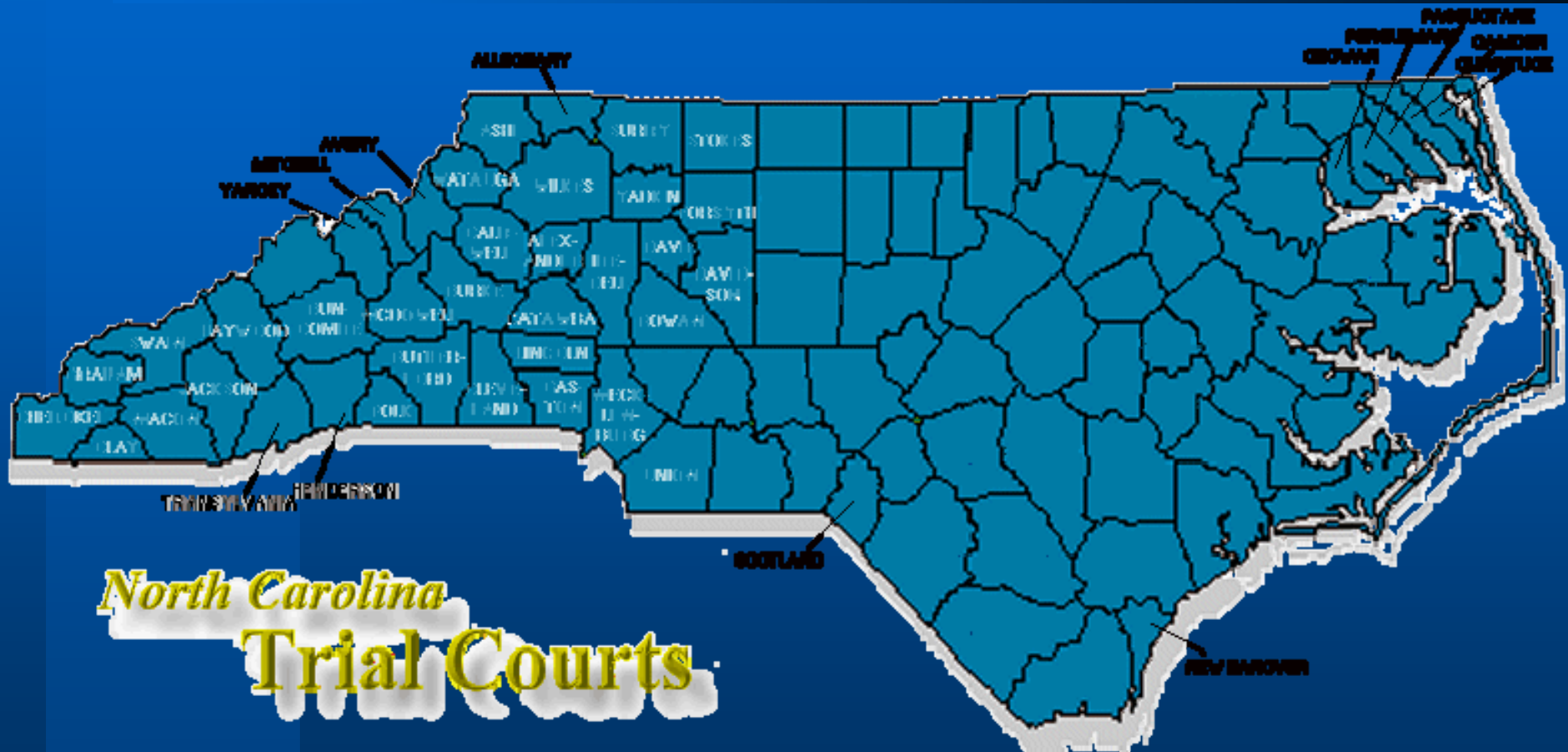

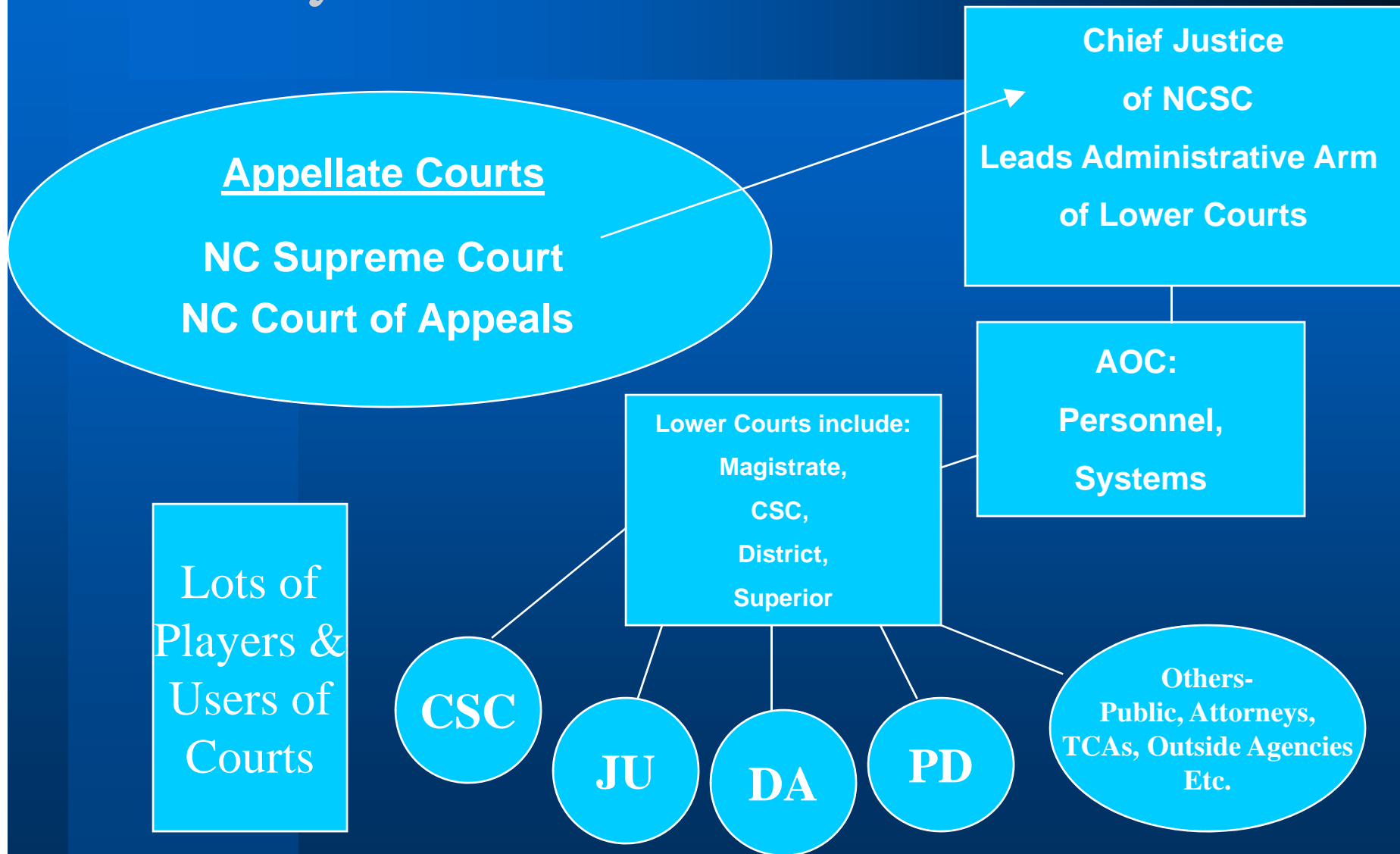

NC's 100 Counties

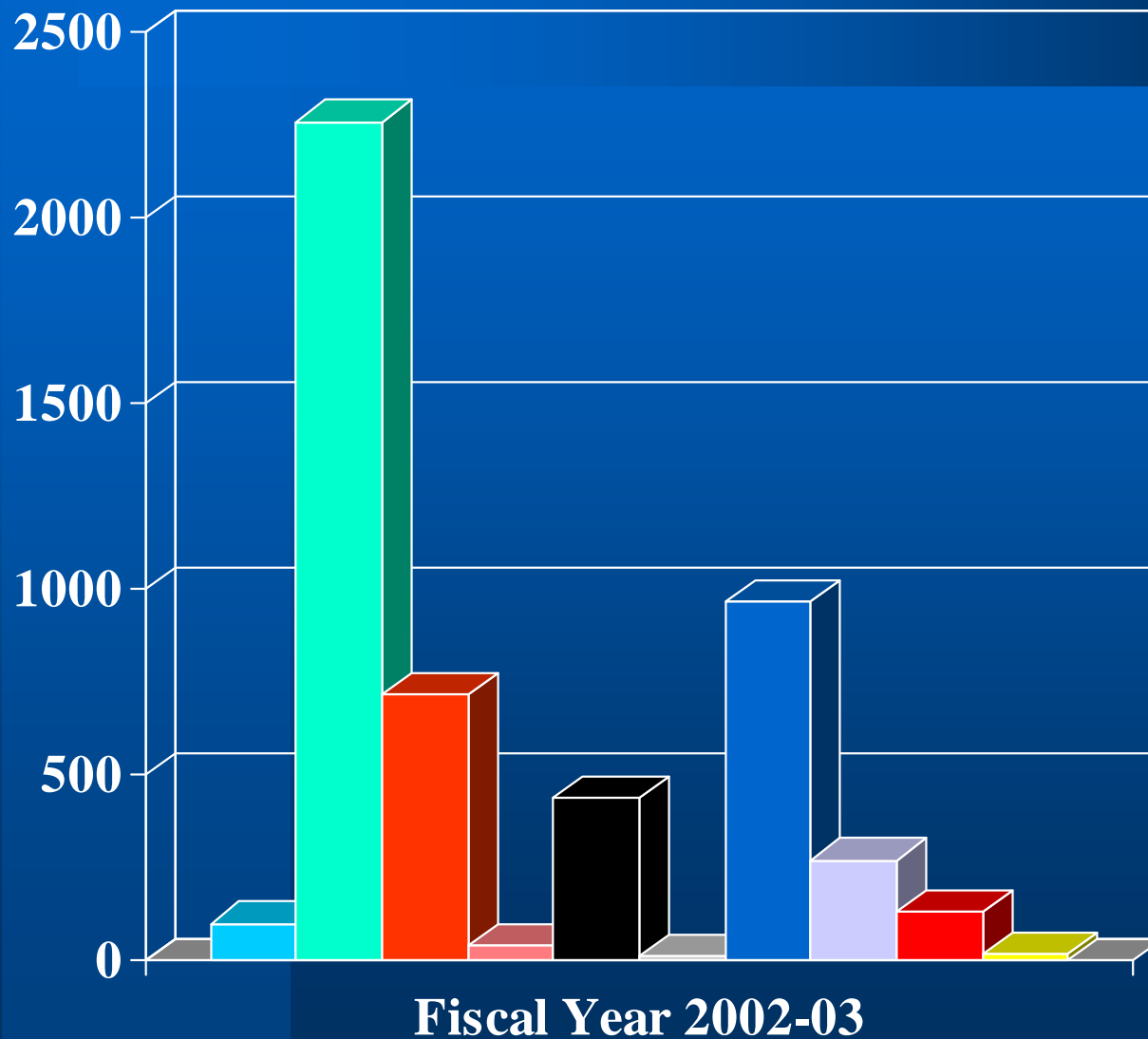

Court System in NC

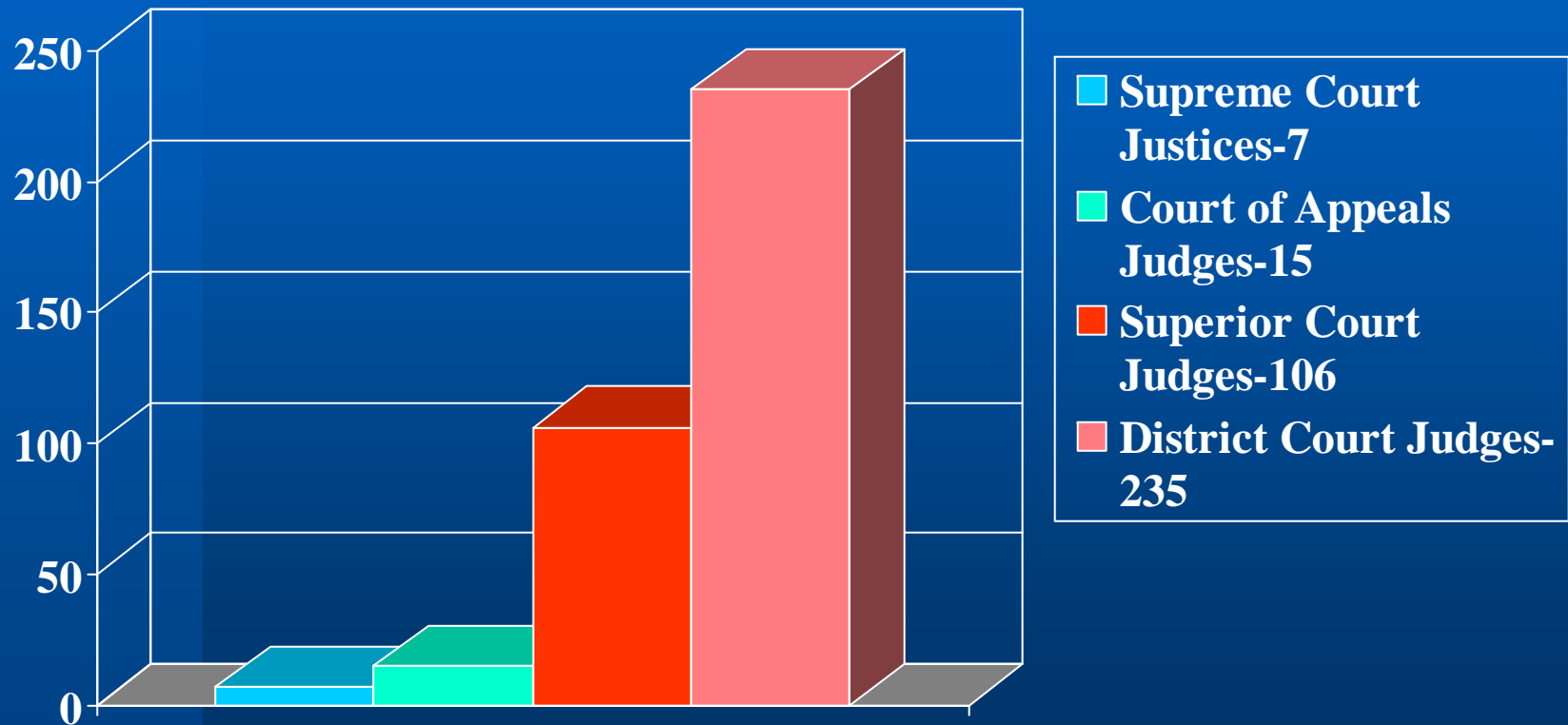

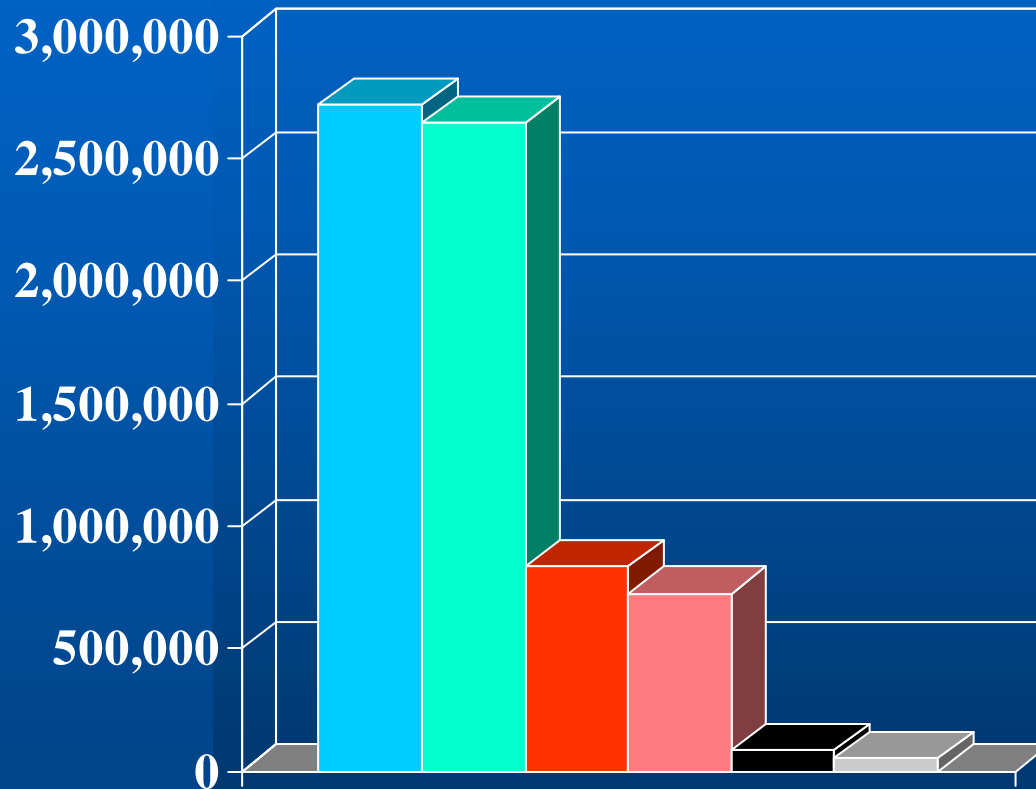

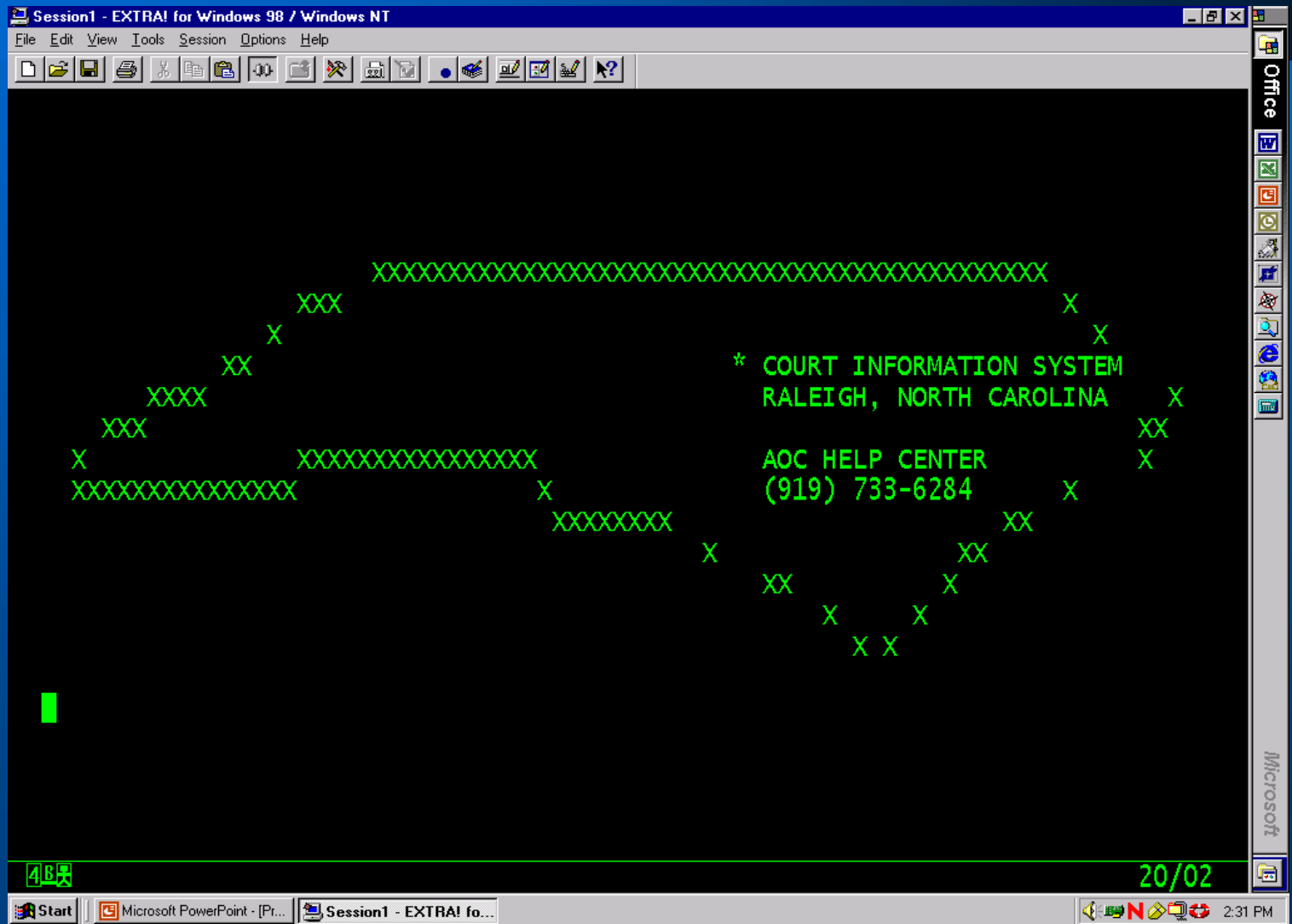

A Brief History of ACIS



- **Developed circa 1980/82**
 - **First installed in Wake County Clerk of Superior Court's Office in 1982**
 - **Now in all 100 counties in NC**
 - **Has been enhanced many times**
 - **Is one of the best Statewide Systems in U.S. (Unifies, good structure)**
 - **In the process of being rewritten**

ACIS is “Green Screen”



What ACIS Does Today

- 24/7 system where judicial department users issue processes and collect official court records (criminal and infraction in nature)
- Available to public 24/7 (via web sites or from 8-5 pm in CSC offices)
- Statewide System for both - district and superior courts (only)
- Collects Crimes, Infractions, Related Events
- Acts as a repository of defendant names, pending and disposed offenses and related court information
- Allows automated name searches, produces court calendars, OFAs, subpoenas, notices and other reports
- For processes filed manually and electronically
 - Law enforcement (citations, warrants, magistrate orders, eCitation, etc) (bulk)
 - Magistrate's (300+ PCs statewide)
 - Clerks - adding cases and data straight into ACIS, including case updates, dispositions and other activities such as
 - 20day failures
 - civil revocations
 - probation violations, etc.

 - **Other AOC Systems**
 - **Financial Management System**
 - **Magistrate's System**
 - **VCAP (civil records, etc.)**
 - **Courtflow,**
 - **Etc.**

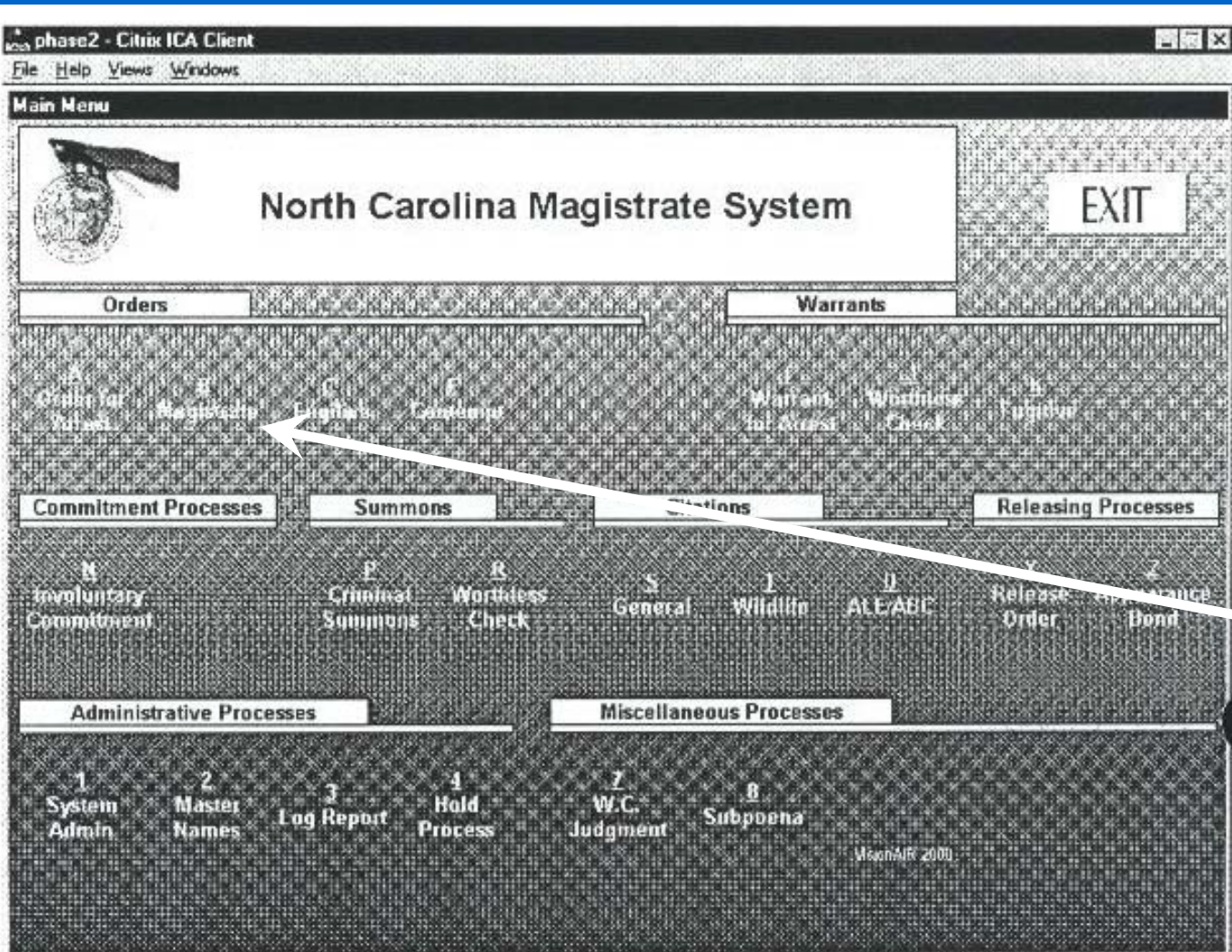
CHAPTER 1 MAGISTRATE SYSTEM OVERVIEW

1.1 Welcome

The Magistrate System is a computer software package that provides integration of the daily functions of the magistrate court system. This product provides users with the tools to enhance their efficiency and access to the data that will increase their productivity. Both new and experienced computer users will find the Magistrate System program user friendly and simple to master.

The North Carolina Magistrate System enables court agencies to manage vital records, such as warrants and orders, easily and effectively. MAGISTRATE SYSTEM also incorporates large master databases for storing name and address information. The more you use the system, the more these master databases will ease your workload; saving details that can be recalled in the future.

The Magistrate System includes automated warnings for outstanding warrants, warrant/offense history, and involvement history. These warnings are based on entries made into the Master Name database.



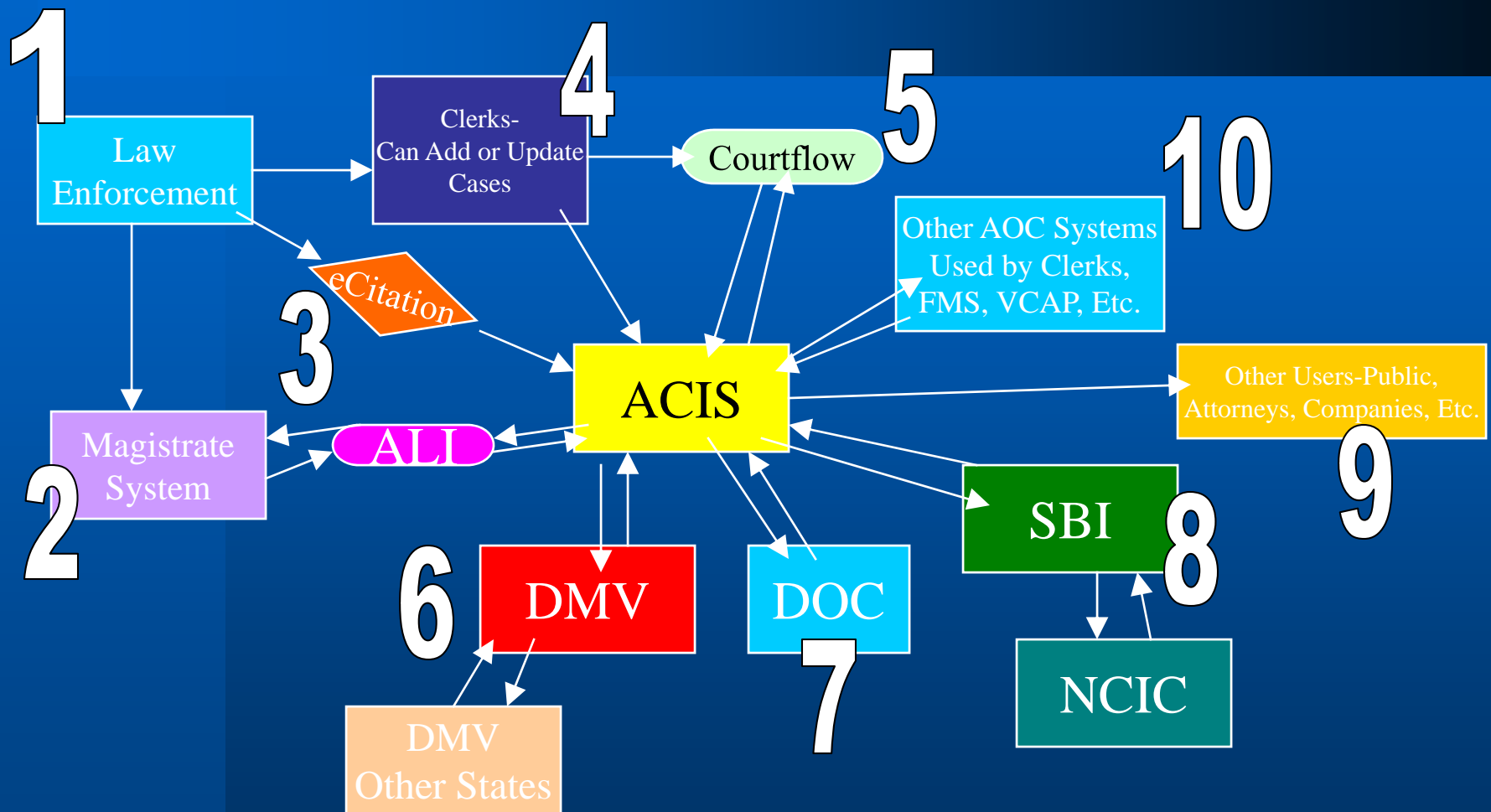
