NC SHSP Implementation Survey Results

- 2014 NC SHSP - 149 Total Supporting Actions
 - Before the Survey – 80 Supporting Actions identified as “Needed”
 - Before the Survey - 44% of the Supporting Actions are either currently planned, underway or ongoing
 - After the Survey – 61 Supporting Actions identified as “Needed”
 - After the Survey - 59% of the Supporting Actions are either currently planned, underway or ongoing

NC SHSP Implementation

Implementation Priority Ranking – High Priority

- Lane Departure
- Strategy: Keep vehicles on the roadway.
 - Supporting Action: Coordinate with other emphasis areas where the root cause of lane departure is related to driver behavior instead of or in addition to an engineering issue.
- Implementing Agencies: **NCDOT**
- Status: ~~Needed~~ **Planned or Underway**
