## Objectives:

- 1. Develop an overall NC State plan that expands upon the GHSP's older driver priority by supporting and working collaboratively with local jurisdictions to implement older driver strategies aimed at reducing older driver (and pedestrian) fatalities and injuries resulting from motor vehicle crashes.
- 2. Facilitate greater communication and collaboration between the leadership in NC driver licensing, the medical review unit, medical providers in NC, social services, NC law enforcement (NC State Highway Patrol and local law enforcement), the state aging and social services in meeting older drivers' needs through a more actively engaged NC Senior Driver Safety Coalition/Older Driver Working Group.
- 3. Develop and implement educational opportunities for the key elements in driver licensing for the medically-at-risk, medical providers, law enforcement, and social and aging service providers.
