	Number of Studies Showing <b>Decrease</b>	Number of Studies 1 Showing Increase
Red Light Running Crashes	3	0
Right Angle Crashes	6	1
Rear End Crashes	0	5
Fatal or Injury Crashes	6	1

# Review of Research on the Safety Effects of Red-light Cameras

### Comparison to Traffic Signals

Crash Type	Traffic Signal	Red-Light Camera
Right angle	52% decrease	19% to 67% decrease (median decrease 26%)
Fatal or Injury	32% decrease	10% to 21% decrease (median decrease 18.5%)  One study showed 22% increase
Rear end	58% increase	0% to 34% increase (median increase 14.5%)

### Information on City-Operated RLC Programs

Are there cities that operate their own RLC program (i.e., no contractor)?

- Contacted 30 mid-to-large cities known to have RLC programs
- 11 cities provided feedback
- Finding: All cities use a contractor to run some or all aspects of their RLC program

### Information on City-Operated RLC Programs

#### Combination city/contractor programs

- Conducted in larger cities (New York, Philadelphia, Chicago, Toronto)
- City of Wilmington operates in this manner
- City provided oversight and handled certain aspects (e.g., reviewing citations, issuing fines, selecting locations for the cameras)
- Contractor handled equipment installation and maintenance

### Cost Effects of Officer-issued Red-light Citations

What is the total financial cost to drivers if they get a ticket from an officer?

- Drivers convicted of red light running would suffer higher financial consequences from an officer-issued citation than a RLC fine
- Fine (\$50) + Court costs (\$183)
- Insurance premium increases:
  - Geico: \$140 increase per month for 6 months
  - Progressive: \$33 to \$50 increase per month for 3 years
  - Allstate: 20-30% rate increase for 3 years
