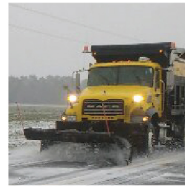

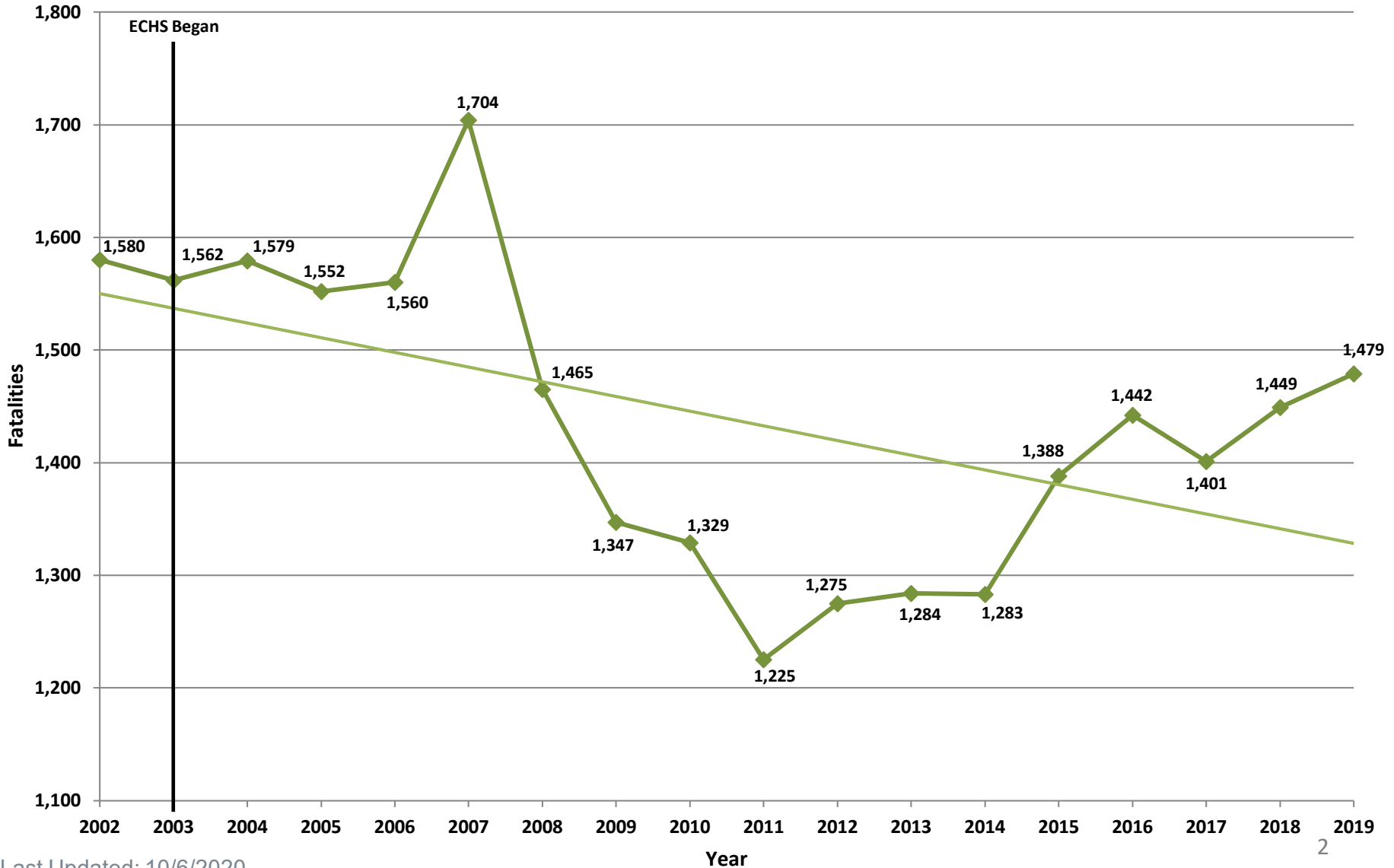

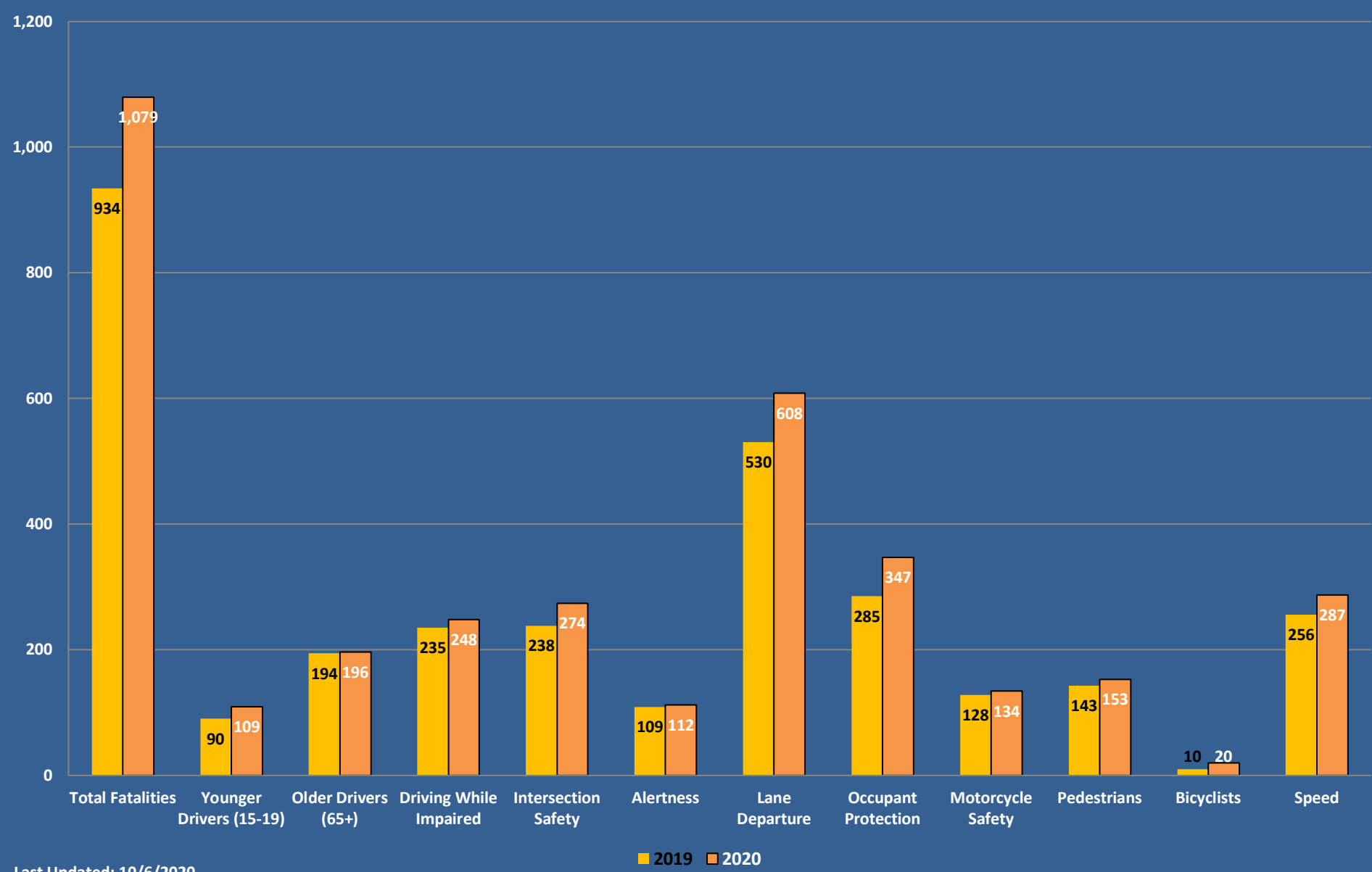

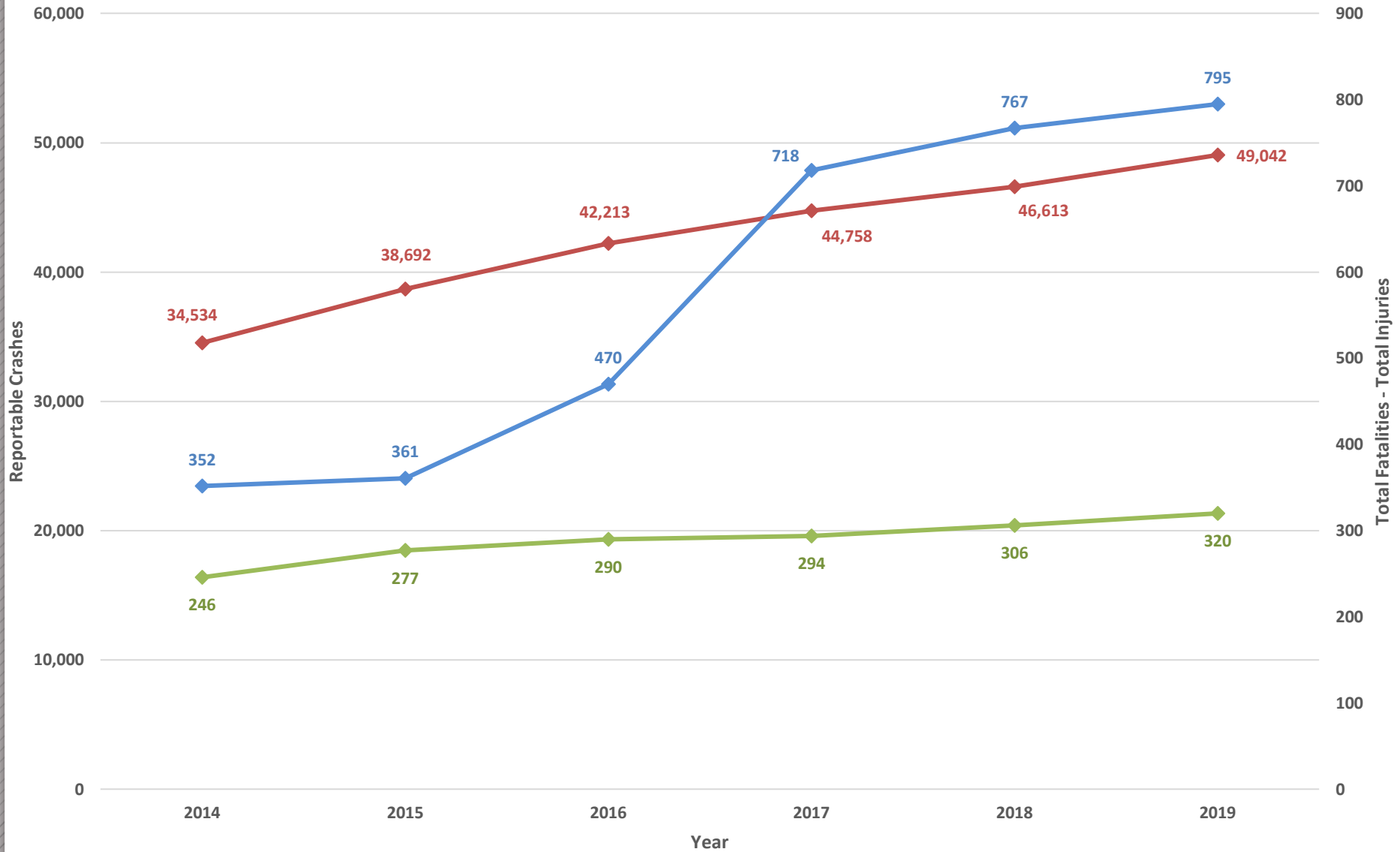
North Carolina Fatalities Trends Since 2002

North Carolina Older Driver (65+) Crash Facts

From January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2019

- 71% of the older driver crashes occur in urban locations
- 66% of the older driver crash fatalities and serious injuries occur in rural locations
- From 2014 to 2019, there was a **30% increase** in older driver crash fatalities

North Carolina Older Driver (65+) Crash Facts

From January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2019

Nearly 50% of older driver crashes

- Top 10 Counties - Mecklenburg, Wake, Guilford, Forsyth, Buncombe, Durham, Cumberland, New Hanover, Gaston, Catawba and Cabarrus County

Nearly 30% of older driver fatalities

- Top 10 Counties - Mecklenburg, Guilford, Wake, Forsyth, Buncombe, Robeson, Cumberland, Brunswick, Johnston and Gaston County
