




# North Carolina Fatalities Trends Since 2002

## North Carolina Older Driver (65+) Crash Facts

From January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2019

71% of the older driver crashes occur in urban locations

 66% of the older driver crash fatalities and serious injuries occur in rural locations

From 2014 to 2019, there was a 30% increase in older driver crash fatalities

## North Carolina Older Driver (65+) Crash Facts

From January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2019

#### Nearly 50% of older driver crashes
