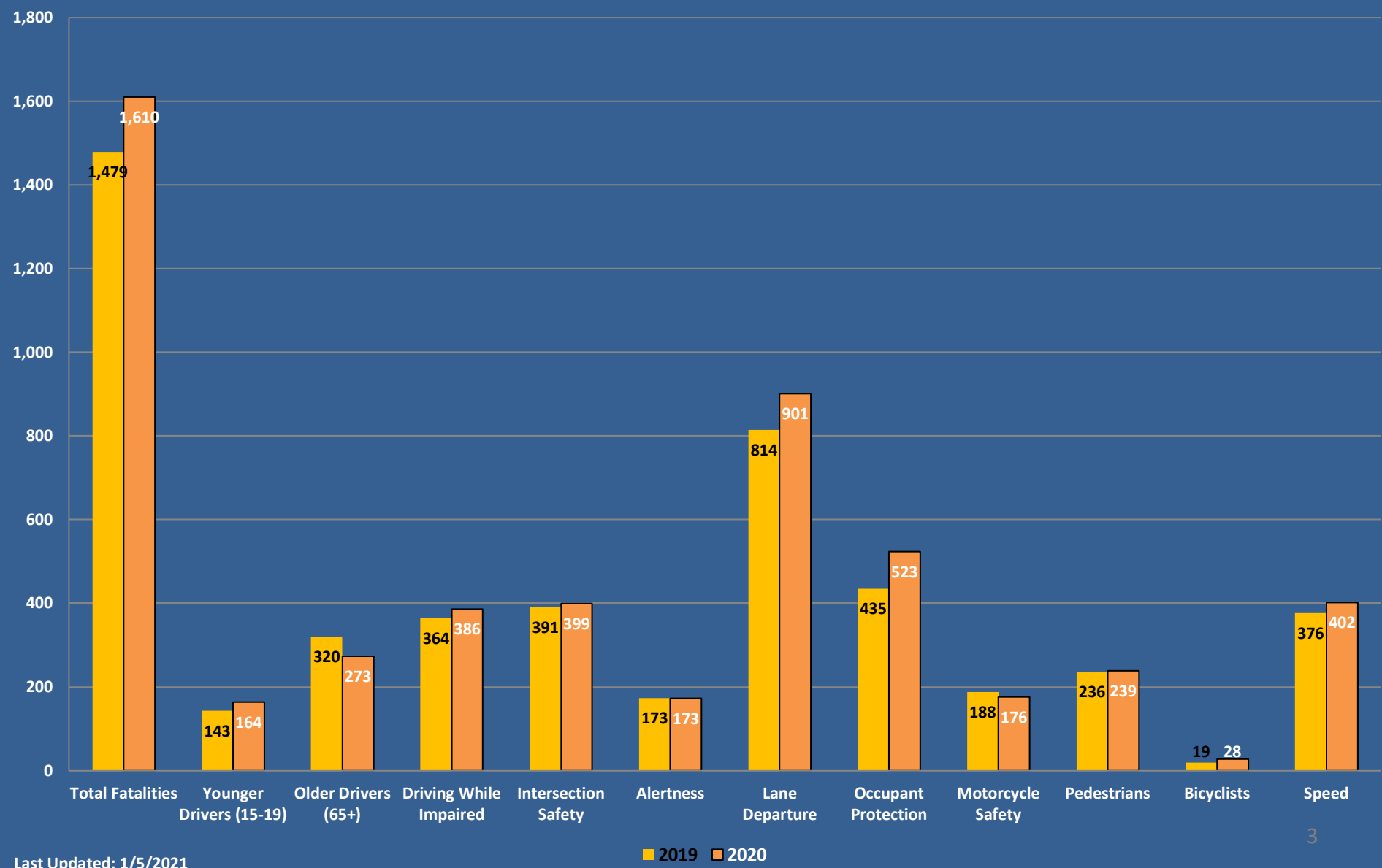

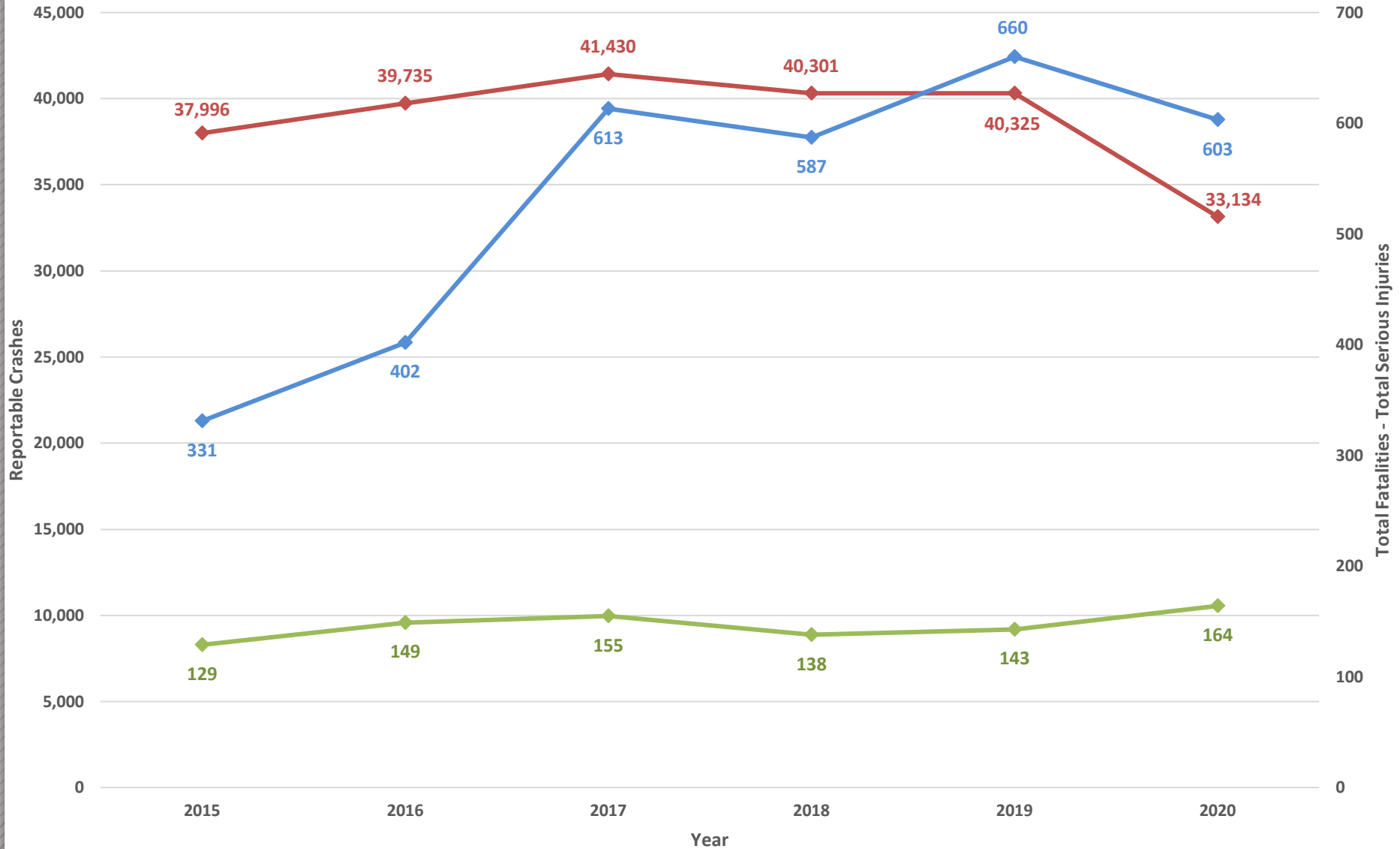
North Carolina Fatalities Trends Since 2002

North Carolina Younger Driver (15-19) Crash Facts

From January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2020

- 65% of the younger driver **crashes** occur in urban locations
- 70% of the younger driver crash **fatalities and serious injuries** occur in rural locations
- From 2015 to 2020, there was a **27% increase** in younger driver crash fatalities

North Carolina Younger Driver (15-19) Crash Facts

From January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2020

Nearly 50% of younger driver crashes

- Top 10 Counties - Mecklenburg, Wake, Guilford, Forsyth, Union, Durham, Cumberland, Buncombe, Cabarrus and Pitt County

35% of younger driver fatalities

- Top 10 Counties – Wake, Mecklenburg, Guilford, Harnett, Davidson, Cumberland, Robeson, Randolph, Johnston and Nash County
