Opened meeting at 1:30 PM, January 6, 2010 at the Chief Engineer's Conference Room. There were no late comers.

Distributed Plans and bid Proposals.

B4700X Proposal:

1. **Pg. 3, Holiday Lane Restrictions**, Item 9– Add Bele Chere festival restriction.
2. Add **“Cooperation Between Contractors” Special Provision to Pg. 13**
3. **Pg. 32, Bid Sheet** – Delete item for **“Cleaning and Repainting Bridge #59”**

These minutes are made part of the applicable contract.

HOLIDAY AND HOLIDAY WEEKEND LANE CLOSURE RESTRICTIONS:

1. For **unexpected occurrence** that creates unusually high traffic volumes, as directed by the Engineer.
2. For **New Year's Day**, between the hours of 7:00 pm December 31st to 6:00 am January 2nd. If New Year's Day is on Friday, Saturday, Sunday or Monday, then until 6:00 am the following Tuesday.
3. For **Easter**, between the hours of 7:00 pm Thursday and 6:00 am Monday.
4. For **Memorial Day**, between the hours of 7:00 pm Friday and 6:00 am Tuesday.
5. For **Independence Day**, between the hours of 7:00 pm the day before Independence Day and 6:00 am the day after Independence Day.
If Independence Day is on a Friday, Saturday, Sunday or Monday, then between the hours of 7:00 pm the Thursday before Independence Day and 6:00 am the Tuesday after Independence Day.
6. For **Labor Day**, between the hours of 7:00 pm Friday and 6:00 am Tuesday.
7. For **Thanksgiving Day**, between the hours of 7:00 pm Tuesday and 6:00 am Monday.
8. For **Christmas**, between the hours of 7:00 pm the Friday before the week of Christmas Day and 6:00 am the following Tuesday after the week of Christmas Day.
9. For the Bele Chere Festival, between the hours of 7:00 pm the Friday before the festival to 6:00 am the Sunday after the festival.

Holidays and holiday weekends shall include New Years, Easter, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas. The Contractor shall schedule his work so that lane closures are not required during these periods, unless otherwise directed by the Engineer.

The time of availability for this intermediate contract time shall be the time the Contractor begins to install all traffic control devices for daytime and nighttime lane closures according to the time restrictions listed above.

The completion time for this intermediate contract time shall be the time the Contractor is required to complete the removal of traffic control devices required for daytime and nighttime lane closures according to the time restrictions stated above and restore traffic to the existing pattern.

The liquidated damages are Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) per 15 minute period.

E. CONSTRUCTION METHODS

The contractor shall perform all construction activities in accordance with the applicable requirements of the NCDOT Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures dated July 2006, except as otherwise specified herein.

- (3) Coordinate and cooperate with Traffic Management Center personnel in Wake County to ensure proper messages are displayed on the CMSs (Changeable Message Sign) and Dynamic Message Sign (DMS) that guide motorists to designated alternate detour routes.
- (4) Provide traffic control set up that ensures safe traffic operations throughout the construction area.
- (5) Provide traffic control set up that ensures workers' safety throughout the construction area.
- (6) Attend any scheduled meetings as required by the Engineer.

Measurement and Payment

There will be no direct payment for the Traffic Control Supervisor as this is considered incidental to the cost of providing traffic control devices to the project.

Description

Furnish law enforcement officers and marked law enforcement vehicles to direct traffic in accordance with the contract.

Construction Methods

Use uniformed law enforcement officers and marked law enforcement vehicles equipped with lights mounted on top of the vehicle and law enforcement vehicle emblems to direct or control traffic as required by the plans or by the Engineer.

Measurement and Payment

Law Enforcement will be measured and paid for in the actual number of hours that each law enforcement officer is provided during the life of the project as approved by the Engineer. There will be no direct payment for marked law enforcement vehicles as they are considered incidental to the pay item.
