

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SUBJECT: Certification of Eligibility under the Iran Divestment Act

On June 29, 2015, Governor McCrory signed into law the Iran Divestment Act which prohibits certain investments and contracts with persons determined to be engaging in investment activities in Iran. The Department of State Treasurer was tasked with developing a list of prohibited companies and individuals ("Final Divestment List") under the Act. The Final Divestment List includes the Final Divestment List-Iran as well as the Parent and Subsidiary Guidance-Iran list. The Final Divestment List was published on February 26, 2016 which triggered the Act's investment and contracting prohibitions to go into effect. Therefore, any Contractor that was awarded a project on or after the February 26, 2016 date is required to sign a **Certification of Eligibility**.

Through this letter, I am informing you of the need to submit the attached Certification of Eligibility to be submitted with your other contract execution documents. If the Certification of Eligibility is not signed, the contract will not be executed.

**CERTIFICATION OF ELIGIBILITY
Under the Iran Divestment Act**

Pursuant to G.S. 147-86.59, any person identified as engaging in investment activities in Iran, determined by appearing on the Final Divestment List created by the State Treasurer pursuant to G.S. 147-86.58, is ineligible to contract with the State of North Carolina or any political subdivision of the State. The Iran Divestment Act of 2015, G.S. 147-55 *et seq.** requires that each vendor, prior to contracting with the State certify, and the undersigned on behalf of the Vendor does hereby certify, to the following:

1. that the vendor is not identified on the Final Divestment List of entities that the State Treasurer has determined engages in investment activities in Iran;
2. that the vendor shall not utilize on any contract with the State agency any subcontractor that is identified on the Final Divestment List; and
3. that the undersigned is authorized by the Vendor to make this Certification.
