All events and dates set forth in the Anticipated Procurement Schedule and elsewhere in the RFP are subject to change at NCDOT's sole discretion, and the Proposer shall be solely responsible for monitoring the Anticipated Procurement Schedule for any such changes.

All times listed in the Anticipated Procurement Schedule and elsewhere in the RFP are local, Eastern Time in Raleigh, North Carolina, for the applicable date. If any of the time periods set forth in the Anticipated Procurement Schedule or this RFP fall on a non-Business Day, then such period shall automatically be extended to the next Business Day.

2 Purpose and Background

North Carolina's freeways experience sudden unexpected slowdowns and work zones that require drivers to change lanes. These situations, encountered at high speeds, can negatively impact traveler safety and mobility. Providing in-vehicle hands-free, eyes free alerts for these conditions will give drivers specific, timely and actionable information to respond to upcoming road anomalies.

In response to this need, NCDOT was selected as one of the FY2022 United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) Strengthening Mobility and Revolutionizing Transportation (SMART) Grant awardees (https://www.transportation.gov/grants/SMART). The SMART Grant Program is organized in two stages. NCDOT was awarded the Stage 1, Planning and Prototyping Grant which is required to be complete within eighteen (18) months – September 15, 2023, to March 15, 2025. (NCDOT will request an extension to Stage 1 to allow for deployment and evaluation time. All dates in this RFP are based on USDOT granting NCDOT a time extension for this project.) NCDOT will evaluate the Stage 1 deployment and if awarded, progress to a Stage 2 Implementation Grant which is required to be complete within thirty-six (36) months.

2.1 System Concept

The Stage 1 Grant supports development of a system that provides automated, actionable handsfree, eyes-free alerts about anomalies to motorists on North Carolina freeways through existing smartphone applications and navigation systems. *Automating Actionable Road Anomalies (AARA)* –

The Price Proposal shall be submitted by returning the Request for Proposals with Appendix A—Price Proposal, and all required signatures and bonds. Failure to execute the required documents may render the Price Proposal non-responsive.

4.1 Proposal Selection Procedure

NCDOT has formed a Technical Review Committee with the necessary business and technical expertise to assess the Vendor's abilities, strengths, and weaknesses based on the proposal responses. NCDOT shall review all Vendor responses to confirm they meet the requirements of the Scope of Work. NCDOT reserves the right to waive any minor informality or technicality in the proposals reviewed.

After issuance of this Industry Draft RFP to short-listed Proposers from the RFQ process, the Department will hold 1-on-1 Question & Answers meetings with Proposers. Afterward, a Final RFP will be distributed to the Proposers for solicitation. The RFP process concludes after the Technical Review Committee reviews technical proposals and NCDOT determines the Preferred Vendor(s).

To ensure that information is distributed equitably to all short-listed Teams, all questions and requests for information shall be directed to the State Contract Officer through the Alternative Delivery e-mail address (altdelivery@ncdot.gov). This precludes any team member, or representative, from contacting representatives of the Department, other State Agencies or Federal Agencies either by phone, e-mail or in person concerning the Design-Build Project.

NCDOT will evaluate the proposals according to completeness, content, and experience with the ability of the Vendor and their staff. Specific criteria are listed in the Technical Evaluation Criteria below. Vendors are required to demonstrate an understanding of tasks and responsibilities defined within each requirement identified throughout this scope of work and each requirement shall be addressed as requested.

4.3.6 Proposed Personnel (Requirement 6)

In the technical proposal: The Proposer shall provide resumes of key individuals that will be part of this project, i.e. Project Manager, Key Staff and other members of the Team. <u>The RESPONSES shall not count toward the page count for the Technical Proposal.</u>

4.3.7 Price Proposal (Appendix A)

The Proposer shall define the costs associated with the proposed services by filling in the Price Proposal in Appendix A.

Payments will be made upon approval of Deliverables described in Section 3.5.4.

- Deployment and System Test will be paid upon NCDOT approval of Deployment and System Test Verification Memo.
- Half of the System Operations Service Total will be paid upon NCDOT approval of Draft Systems Operations Memo.
- Half of the System Operations Service Total will be paid upon NCDOT approval of Final System Operations Memo.

4.4 Question and Answer Meeting

Due to the unique nature of the work involved in this contract, all short-listed teams will be required to attend an individual question and answer meeting with the Department to address project specifics and address questions related to this procurement and this RFP. These meetings will be held on August 22, 2024, via Microsoft Teams. Each Team will be provided with a one-hour time slot that has been predetermined and transmitted via a letter from the State Contracts Engineer.

A Second Question and Answer Meeting will be held October 2, 2024, via Microsoft Teams, at the discretion of the Department.

4.5 Disadvantaged Business Enterprises

The NCDOT is committed to complying with the North Carolina General Statute 136-28.4 with respect to disadvantaged minority-owned and women-owned business enterprises (MBE and WBE) for state funded projects and supporting Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) firms on federally funded projects. A DBE goal may be set forth in the Request for Proposals (RFP) but if not the utilization of additional DBE/WBE/MBE firms as well as Small Professional Service Firms will be encouraged.

4.6 General Information

It is not the intention of NCDOT to receive project specific design or engineering recommendations in response to this RFP. Proposers should limit their submittals to the information required by this RFP scope of work.

NCDOT reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to either proceed no further with the Project procurement process or to re-advertise in another public solicitation.

The NCDOT reserves the right to accept or reject any of the Proposal responses and / or discontinue the selection process at any time prior to contract execution.
