SUMMARY OF HISTORIC ARCHITECTURE AND LANDSCAPES REVIEW

<u>Description of review activities, results, and conclusions:</u> Review of HPO quad maps, HPO GIS information, historic designations roster, and indexes was undertaken on April 15, 2026. Based on this review, there are no existing NR, SL, LD, DE, or SS properties in the Area of Potential Effects, which is defined on the following maps. There is one property over fifty years of age within the APE and it was visually surveyed through Google Maps Street View, and from this survey it was determined it is unremarkable and does not warrant further evaluation. Bridge No.239 is not eligible for National Register listing. There are no National Register listed or eligible properties and no survey is required. If design plans change, additional review will be required. <u>Why the available information provides a reliable basis for reasonably predicting that there are no unidentified significant historic architectural or landscape resources in the project area:</u> HPO quad maps and GIS information recording NR, SL, LD, DE, and SS properties for the Rutherford County survey, Rutherford County GIS/Tax information, and Google Maps are considered valid for the purposes of determining the likelihood of historic resources being present. There are no National Register listed or eligible properties within the APE and no survey is required.
