SUMMARY OF HISTORIC ARCHITECTURE AND LANDSCAPES REVIEW

DESCRIPTION OF REVIEW ACTIVITIES, RESULTS, AND CONCLUSIONS: HPOWeb reviewed on 6 December 2016 and yielded no NR, SL, DE, SS, or LD properties in the Area of Potential Effects (APE). Wayne County current GIS mapping, aerial photography, and tax information indicated a mostly wooded APE including a church building, which stands approximately 400 feet southwest of the existing bridge and is an unexceptional example of its type. Bridge No. 156, now washed-out, was built in 1960 and not eligible for the National Register as it was neither aesthetically nor technologically significant.

No architectural survey is required for the project as currently defined.

WHY THE AVAILABLE INFORMATION PROVIDES A RELIABLE BASIS FOR REASONABLY PREDICTING THAT THERE ARE NO UNIDENTIFIED SIGNIFICANT HISTORIC ARCHITECTURAL OR LANDSCAPE RESOURCES IN THE PROJECT AREA: APE extends 500 feet from either end of the existing bridge (E-W) and 100 feet to either side of the SR 1101 (Raynor Mill Road) centerline (N-S) to encompass proposed construction activities. The comprehensive county survey (1995-7) and related publication as well as later studies, record no properties in the APE (J. Daniel Pezzoni and Penne Smith, *Glimpses of Wayne County, North Carolina: An Architectural History* (Goldsboro, NC: Wayne County Historical Association, 1998)). No National Register-listed properties are located within the APE. Google Maps "Street View" and other graphics confirm the absence of architectural and landscape resources in the APE subject to both GS 121-12(a) and Section 106 compliance.

Should the project limits or design change, or any improvements be planned along an off-site detour, please notify NCDOT Historic Architecture as additional review may be necessary.

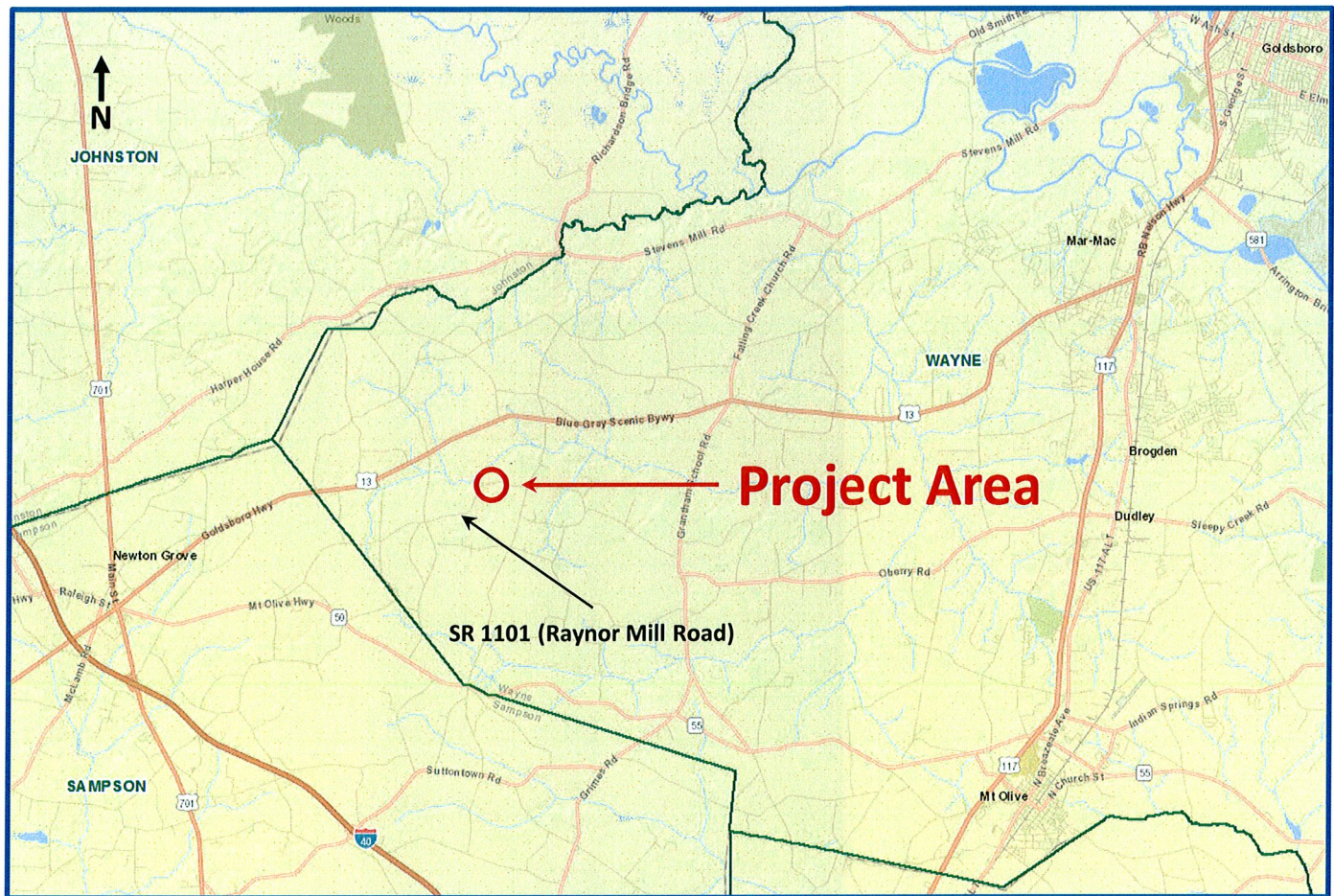
