QUESTIONS ASKED:

- 1. Q) What is the budget for this project?
 - A) 75 million dollars
- 2. Q) If the Design Build Team stays within the existing Right of Way footprint with its design, does NCDOT anticipate any wetland mitigation issues?
 - A) No, if construction stays within existing ROW there should not be any mitigation issues.
- 3. Q) Is a CPM schedule required at the Request For Qualifications (RFQ) stage?
 - A) No. A general outline of the proposed schedule is needed for the RFQ. The CPM schedule is necessary for the RFP.
- 4. Q) What will be the requirements for the plan development process for this Design-Build project?
 - A) The plan development process will be outlined in the RFP for each Unit. NCDOT is leaning towards 25% and 100% plan complete submittals.
- 5. Q) Is there a preliminary estimate for the number of technicians needed for inspection?
 - A) No.
- **6.** Q) Will a consultant to the Design-Build team (i.e. Geotechnical, ITS, etc.) be able to perform the CEI work?
 - A) No firm that does any design work may inspect it's own work. Therefore, a firm that participates in any way in the design of the project CANNOT perform the CEI work.

- 7. Q) Can the design firm supply construction stakeout crew(s)?
 - A) Yes
- 8. Q) Is the geotechnical information for this project the same as the other 2 design-build projects?
 - A) Yes.
- **9.** Q) What other information will be available to prospective proposers?
 - A) RFQ guidelines, locations & surveys information, traffic data surveys, preliminary geotechnical information, planning document, 25 % complete plans. All of this information will be posted on our Design-Build web page as it becomes available.
- 10. Q) What are the DBE expectations for this project?
 - A) For the RFP, points will be awarded for using DBEs as part of the Design-Build team. For construction, a DBE goal will be set as in any other NCDOT project.
- 11. Q) Is CEI, in relation to DBEs, considered part of the construction side or the design side?
 - A) Part of the Design side it will not be part of the construction % goal.
- 12. Q) As a federally funded project, will signing plans have to be submitted directly to the FHWA?
 - A) No.
