


## Key Features on Map 6

- End R-2828 @ 955+00





#### **RFQ**

- Nearly identical to NCDOT pursuits
  - Request RFQ package
  - RFQ Holder List will be maintained
  - Preconstruction Firm Restrictions and Exceptions
  - Prequalification Requirements
  - Evaluation Criteria
  - Submit Statement of Qualifications on time with close attention to page limits
- Financial Qualifications and Surety Letter

#### **RFQ**

- Anticipated scopes of work noted in RFQ and the Project Synopsis to be on website
- AET and ITS components for tolling operations are not part of these contracts
- CEI performed by NCDOT or its agent(s)
- Right of Way acquisition scope will vary by project

#### **Provided Materials**

- All environmental documents are online at website noted at end of presentation
- Other materials will be provided to shortlisted teams through a dedicated shared site
- Materials to include preliminary design files, geotechnical inventory, preliminary utility information, right of way plans for R-2721A and R-2721B, surveys, etc.

### RFP and DB Proposal

- Nearly identical to NCDOT pursuits
  - ATCs (but unlimited)
  - Industry Draft RFPs (3) followed by one-on-one meetings
  - Two additional one-on-one meetings
  - Evaluation criteria and adjusted price
  - Pavement designs will be specified, including alternate types
- Same TRC for both phases but will differ by project

#### Contract Award and Finance

- Anticipated combination of TIFIA, GARVEE, STIP and Toll Revenue Bonds to fund project
- Advanced funding for preconstruction portions of contracts
- Limited Notice to Proceed
- Unlimited Notice to Proceed upon financial close
- Extended bid validity periods likely with potential escalation provisions for unanticipated delays in Unlimited Notice to Proceed

#### DBE Goals and Considerations

DBE Goals:

- R-2828: 10%

- R-2721A: 12%

- R-2721B: 12%

- Applies to construction and right of way portion of contract commensurate with past DB procurements
- DBE participation in preconstruction efforts considered as part of evaluation (both phases)






# Area 1 (Sunset Lake Rd) Project Scope

- Install approximately 1400 LF of 6" x 0.500" w.t. pipe via HDD method
- Tie-in new 6" HDD pipe to existing line
- Clean, abandon, and remove existing line crossing
- Estimated construction start: Sep 2018
- Estimated construction end: Mar 2019

# Area 2 (West Lake Road) Project Scope

- Install approximately 1,630 LF of 16" x 0.500" w.t. pipe via open cut & Jack-and-Bore methods
- Tie-in new 16" pipe to existing line
- Clean, abandon, and remove existing lines between tie-in points
- Estimated construction start: Sep 2018
- Estimated construction end: May 2019




# Area 3 (Pony Solder Drive) Project Scope

- Install approximately 100 LF of 2" concrete jacketing onto existing line under proposed Pony Soldier Drive extension.
- Estimated construction start: Sep 2018
- Estimated construction end: Feb 2019

# Area 4 (Bells Lake Road) Project Scope

- Install approximately 100 LF of 2" concrete jacketing onto existing line on east and west side of Bells Lake Road.
- Estimated construction start: Feb 2019
- Estimated construction end: May 2019




# Area 5 (Fayetteville Road) Project Scope

- Install approximately 4,450 LF of 16" x 0.500" w.t. pipe via open cut & HDD methods
- Tie-in new 16" pipe to existing line
- Clean, abandon, and remove existing lines between tie-in points
- Estimated construction start: Apr 2019
- Estimated construction end: Jan 2020

# Area 6 (Fanny Brown Road) Project Scope

- Initial Road Design showed expansion of ROW which would require extension of concrete jacketing.
- Road was redesigned to remove conflict
- No work required




# Area 7 (Old Stage Road) Project Scope

- Install approximately 7,100 LF of 16" x 0.500" w.t. pipe via open cut & Jack-and-Bore methods
- Tie-in new 16" pipe to existing line
- Clean, abandon, and remove existing lines between tie-in points
- Estimated construction start: Jun 2019
- Estimated construction end: Feb 2020




# Area 8 (Benson Road) Project Scope

- Install approximately 500 LF of 16" x 0.500" w.t. pipe via open cut & Jack-and-Bore methods
- Tie-in new 16" pipe to existing line

- Estimated construction start: May 2019
- Estimated construction end: Oct 2019




# Area 9 (Transmission Line) Project Scope

- Install approximately 1,300 LF of 16" x 0.500" w.t. pipe via HDD method
- Tie-in new 16" pipe to existing line
- Clean, abandon, and remove existing line between tie-in points
- Estimated construction start: Feb 2020
- Estimated construction end: Aug 2020

  - Depending on progress, these projects may allow for DB Team to supplement these efforts with their own firm or further direct NCTA firms in priorities
- DB Team will include ROW firm(s) for R-2828
- 40 parcels underway
- Map Act Some work will be considered Extra Work (reference Forsyth R-2247 DB ROW Scope)
