

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the project entitled **South Mills Wastewater Collection System Improvements** will be received by **Camden County** at **10:00 a.m. local time November 27, 2012** in the Conference Room of the County Manager's Office located at 330 US Highway 158 East, Camden, North Carolina and then publicly opened and read aloud.

The project generally consists of a submersible pump station with all related appurtenances, 660 linear feet of 3-inch diameter pressure sewer line, 290 linear feet of gravity sewer and all related appurtenances.

There will be no refund to any party for Contract Documents so obtained. Neither the Owner nor the Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Contract Documents, including any Addenda, obtained from any other source.

Bidders and other interested parties should note that prequalification of equipment manufacturers by the Engineer prior to the bid opening may be required for this project. Equipment prequalification requirements, if any, are described in the Contract Documents.

A certified check or cashiers check payable to **Camden County** or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by a corporate surety licensed under the laws of North Carolina to execute such bonds in the amount equal to five percent of the total of the bid shall be submitted with each bid.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or reject any or all bids. The Owner reserves the right to award a contract to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.

The successful bidder shall be required to furnish separate, 100 percent Performance and Payment Bonds in compliance with North Carolina General Statutes Section 143-129 and of Article 3 of Chapter 44A. The Performance Bond shall be in full force and effect for one (1) year after the date of final acceptance of the project by the Owner.

The bid deposit shall be retained by the Owner if the successful bidder fails to execute the contract or fails to provide the required bonds, as stated above, within ten (10) days after award of the contract.

Each bidder must be prequalified to perform the work with NCDOT and appropriately licensed as a Contractor in the State of North Carolina and as provided in General Statutes Chapter 87. Each bidder shall make positive efforts to use small and minority owned business enterprises on this project.

A conditional or qualified BID will not be accepted.
