## **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

1. Line items 135 and 136 are for a 15 ft pole and base but not on the plans(see attached). Please advise.

<u>Answer</u>: The information is not included on the plans but in the manual. Article 3: CDOT Implementation Special Provisions See SP-21 Pedestrian Poles and Bases.

Those line items pertain to the Pedestrian Signals the Contractor will have to install at Peach Tree and Sunset Road. They are outlined in the project manual and there should be a plan incorporated in the plans from CDOT Implementation. They will be titled SIG1-SIG5 following the erosions control plan sheets.

2. These items are not on the signal plans. The pedestrian signals will be mounted on the 10 ft poles according to the plans. Usually the 15 ft poles are used for cameras. Please revise plans or remove the 15<sup>th</sup> ft pole line item.

<u>Answer:</u> There will be two different sizes of pedestrian pedestals installed with this project. There will be one 15 ft tall pole and two 10 ft tall poles. Please see attached screenshots to include a google map of the area as well as the Plan sheet 25 indicating where the pole will be located.
