The following items are being issued herein for modification and clarification to the Bid Requirements for the project referenced above.

MODIFICATIONS TO PROJECT MANUAL

- 1) Under Section 00 40 00 “ITEMIZED BID” (page 00 40 00 – 2 and 3), the following items have been modified:

The Electronic Itemized Bid Form available on Bonfire’s website has been revised to reflect the above changes.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1. Are we required to measure vibration on the rail track?

Answer: There is no requirement to measure track vibration.

2. The quantities and lbs/cy ratios listed on sheet S-3 “Bill of Materials” do not equal the bid quantities for concrete and rebar. Does the rebar bid item include the rebar qty in the deck? Please advise.

Answer: The rebar quantities listing on our rebar drawings (S-R#) are accurate. There was an error in the Bill of Materials. Yes, the rebar bid items include the rebar in the deck (54,000lbs foundations and 26,000lbs deck). The Itemized Bid spreadsheet is updated with corrected numbers through this addendum.

3. The specified Stay-In-Place (SIP) metal forms on sheet S-D10 are 3" deep. Our SIP supplier has mentioned the spec 3" SIP forms are not sufficient for the require design loads and length of spans shown on the plans. Will the engineer allow 4" deep SIP metal forms for the 10' spans and 4.5" deep SIP Metal forms for the last span greater than 10'? Please advise.

Answer: Under the design conditions of dead load, reinforcement and concrete weight, with additional 50psf for construction loading, and a deflection of $L/180$, a deck thickness of 8.5" we need a $S=0.65in^3/ft$ and $I=1.51in^4/ft$. The properties of $S=0.65in^3/ft$ and $I=1.51in^4/ft$ are the governing properties and not the 3in of depth. In addition, a deeper deck would increase the dead load of the structure, but the more problematic part is the increase in elevation for the top of the deck that would require changes to the connecting trail at the abutment.

4. How are we to read the loading table provided for the micropiles? Initially, I thought that tension is negative, and compression is positive; but after digging into it some more, I think it is the other way around. The provided loading under the STR. Columns from the table show loads higher than a #14 Gr. 80 center bar can handle. And the service loading would only make sense with positive accounting for tension loading, and negative accounting for compression loading. Or is there another way to evaluate it?

Answer: Correct, compression is negative and tension is positive. For our calculations, we have considered a Gr 80 steel casing with a wall thickness of 0.472" which will assist in transferring the tensile load through the cased length. In AASHTO 10.9.3.10.4, the total tensile load can have the plunge transfer capacity subtracted out and the rebar designed to carry this remaining load alone. We calculated our plunge transfer capacity over a 5' plunge length.

5. In reference to the micropiles, is the STR abbreviation in the table strength or structural?

Answer: STR stands for the results of the factored strength load combinations (LRFD) and SERV is for the unfactored service load combinations.

6. The micropile testing in the general notes calls out a static load test at each bent location, only 2 are included on the bid form. Is one of the demonstration piles to be load tested? Or do I need to include 3 load tests, and 2 demonstration piles?

Answer: The micropile spec states that two sacrificial verification test piles shall be constructed. The sacrificial piles can be located at either of the foundation location but only max. 1 per location.

7. Further clarification is needed for the response to #6 from Addendum #3. Is a non US based cable an acceptable product if it meets the required physical parameters of the specification?

Answer: This project has a Build America, Buy America clause (1.4 SP1 G05) and there are railings available that meet this clause, however in the NCDOT Spec book (Section 106(B)-1st paragraph). A minimal amount of foreign steel can be used provided the combined material cost of the items involved does not exceed 0.1% of the total amount bid for the entire project or \$2,500, whichever is greater. Also, if the component is a high strength fastener, it's required to be domestically produced and cannot be foreign.

8. Question 1 and 7 (from Addendum #3) both ask if ASTM 1094 galvanized rebar can be used instead of the specified ASTM A767. Question 1's response is yes, Question 7's response is no. Please clarify with a final response as to if ASTM 1094 galvanized rebar is allowed.

Answer: The response is no to both. NCDOT does not allow ASTM 1094 galvanized rebar and cannot be used on this project.

9. Drawing S-D34 shows a unidirectional HLMR disk bearing in Detail 1 and a spherical bearing in Detail 5. Sheet S-3 material description shows e.g. Goodco Z-Tech descriptions (which are spherical). The spec shows both multidirectional and unidirectional bearings as disc bearings, which makes sense considering bearing measurement para. refers to laminated elastomeric bearing pads (and other bid package references show elastomeric bearing pads). Spherical bearings aren't laminated elastomeric. Please advise which type of bearings are required.

Answer: The important design parameter (displacements and translations) for the design of the bearings are listed in the specifications. Both bearing types: Spherical and Disk would be acceptable as long as the product can satisfy the design requirements. Independent of the type of bearing, the information needs to be submitted for review and approval.

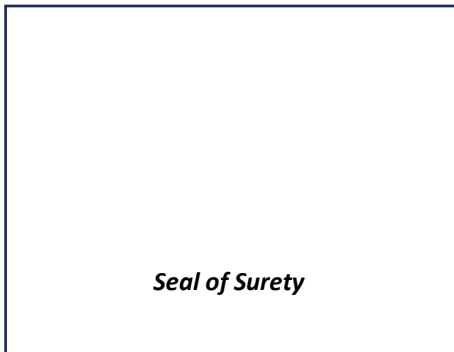

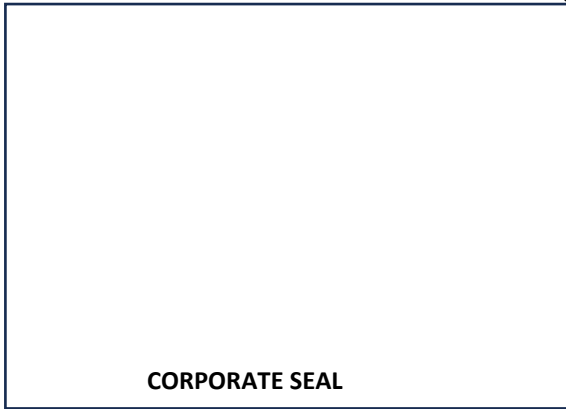
