## Page 1-87, Article 109-8, Fuel Price Adjustments, add the following:

The base index price for DIESEL #2 FUEL is **\$ 1.9362** per gallon. Where any of the following are included as pay items in the contract, they will be eligible for fuel price adjustment.

The Contractor's attention is directed to the Standard Special Provision entitled *Availability of Funds Termination of Contracts* included elsewhere in this proposal. The Department of Transportation's schedule of estimated completion progress for this project as required by that Standard Special Provision is as follows:

Based on availability of funds and the percentage (%) listed above, the work required along any map may be delayed, as directed by the Engineer. In the event that any map is delayed by the Engineer, the completion date listed in the "Contract Time And Liquidated Damages" provision will be extended, in accordance with Article 108-10, however no adjustment in compensation will be considered unless the completion date is delayed for more than 12 months. Should the Contractor's work exceed the percentage (%) listed above for the Fiscal Year, then the difference shall be paid out in three equal payments over the first three months of the following Fiscal Year.

The Contractor shall also furnish his own progress schedule in accordance with Article 108-2 of the 2018 Standard Specifications. Any acceleration of the progress as shown by the Contractor's progress schedule over the progress as shown above shall be subject to availability of funds.
