

INVITATION TO BID

The TOWN OF FALLSTON will accept sealed bids for the construction of the FALLSTON PARK - PHASE II project located on 4531 FALLSTON RD, LAWNDALÉ, NC 28090 (located within the Town of Fallston).

The FALLSTON PARK - PHASE II project includes the installation/construction of concrete paving, picnic shelter, utility work, and landscaping. This scope of work is in conjunction with a separate contract associated with this project. The scope of work is to complete the final phase of construction for this portion of the park project.

All bids must be accompanied by a bid bond or cashier's check in the amount of 5% of the bid payable to TOWN OF FALLSTON.

TOWN OF FALLSTON reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Vendors submitting bids are encouraged to solicit Minority Business Enterprise / Women's Business Enterprise Participation in fulfilling their contract. The bid should indicate MBE/WBE areas of involvement.
