Conditions with 404 permit.

Notify the agency's three weeks before construction starts, for surveys in the water.

We've have endangered potential for protected species in the in the aquatic species in the in the water.

There is a tree clearing restriction. No tree clearing between April one and October 15.

Again, protected species potentially in the trees.

And no, no percussive activity until the trees have been removed if driving piles or jackhammering. This is trout water, so, pay attention to erosion control.

It does show details of concrete washouts of the construction of the temporary Causeway, but you have a temporary Causeway work area.

For installing the in water structures, I have to be removed at the end of the work and restored back to pre project pre construction conditions.

Dewatering inside the work area needs to be done. Per plan sheets through the normal filter.
