Completion – October 1, 2026 with Liquidated Damages of \$600 per calendar day.

All Bids must be received by NCDOT by 2pm.

There are bonds associated with this project.

Standard Bridge Design. This is a 30 ft span length bridge with Steel I beams with timber decking. Boring logs are attached to plans.

Discussed the Special Provision for permits. Building permits are needed and will be submitted by NCEM as soon as a contractor has been awarded the project.

Floodway permit not required.

Ray Bode

Project is considered exempt from 404 permits. No work should occur within the stream. No structures, no parking machinery in the stream. All dewatering must occur from the top. If you have to cross the stream to get to the to access the other side, you can drive through it, but no parking in the stream and doing work while sitting in the water. Object is to not have any sediment discharge.

Questions

1. Does traffic on the existing driveway need to be maintained during construction?
Answer – No, the existing bridge must be removed and the new bridge constructed at the same location.
