Project Description: Stream Repair/Restoration

The North Carolina Department of Transportation is requesting bids for stream repair/restoration of the Middle Fork California Creek south of bridge #31 on SR-1517 (Shake Rag Rd) in Madison County to be let at 2:00 PM on Wednesday, March 16, 2022. **The Contractor shall be prequalified with NCDOT Work Code 1601 STREAM RESTORATION AND CONSTRUCTION to be prequalified to bid on this project.**

The availability date for this project is **April 25, 2022.**

The completion date for this project is **January 27, 2023.**

In order for all prospective bidders to have an extensive knowledge of the project, all prospective bidders shall attend a mandatory pre-bid conference on Thursday March 10, 2022 at 10:30 AM on site at the intersection of US-19 and SR-1517 (Shake Rag Rd) as described in the proposal.

Bids for this project must be submitted electronically. Refer to the Instructions to Bidders in the proposal for more information.

Firms that wish to perform work on Division Purchase Order Contracts as either the prime contractor or as a subcontractor on the project must be prequalified for the type work they wish to perform. Firms that wish to bid on these projects as the prime contractor must be prequalified **prior to submitting your bid.** Firms that wish to perform as a subcontractor to the prime contractor must be prequalified **prior to beginning work on the project.**
