Project Description: Cane River Embankment Repair

The North Carolina Department of Transportation is requesting bids for Cane River embankment repair at Bridge #40 on NC-197 in Yancey County to be let at 2:00 PM on Wednesday, April 20, 2022.

The availability date for this project is **June 1, 2022**.

The completion date for this project is **May 15, 2023**.

In order for all prospective bidders to have an extensive knowledge of the project, all prospective bidders shall attend a mandatory pre-bid conference on Wednesday April 13, 2022 at 1:30 PM on site at Bridge #40 on NC-197 in Yancey County as described in the proposal.

Bids for this project must be submitted electronically. Refer to the Instructions to Bidders in the proposal for more information.

Firms that wish to perform work on Division Purchase Order Contracts as either the prime contractor or as a subcontractor on the project must be prequalified for the type work they wish to perform. Firms that wish to bid on these projects as the prime contractor must be prequalified **prior to submitting your bid**. Firms that wish to perform as a subcontractor to the prime contractor must be prequalified **prior to beginning work on the project**.
