<u>INTERMEDIATE CONTRACT TIME NUMBER #2 AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:</u> (2-20-07) 108 SP1

The Contractor shall complete the required work of installing, maintaining and removing the traffic control devices for lane closures and restoring traffic to the existing traffic pattern. The Contractor shall not close or narrow a lane of traffic on US 25, US 70, NC 81, SR 3548, and SR 2230 in **Buncombe County** during the following time restrictions:

DAY AND TIME RESTRICTIONS

Monday to Sunday From 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

The time of availability for this intermediate contract time will be the time the Contractor begins to install traffic control devices required for the lane closures according to the time restrictions stated herein.

The completion time for this intermediate contract time will be the time the Contractor is required to complete the removal of traffic control devices required for the lane closures according to the time restrictions stated herein and restore traffic to the existing traffic pattern.

The liquidated damages are **One Thousand Dollars** (\$1,000.00) per 15 minute time period.














TYPE 2A

PAY LIMITS FOR 1 CURB RAMP

- (1) 8.33% (12:1) MAX RAMP SLOPE
- (2) CROSS SLOPE: 2.00%
- CURB RAMPS REQUIRE A (4'-0") MINIMUM LANDING
 WITH A MAXIMUM CROSS SLOPE AND LONGITUDINAL SLOPE
 OF 2,00% WHERE PEDESTRIANS PERFORM TURNING MANEUVERS.
 SLOPE TO DRAIN TO CURB.
