The North Carolina Department of Transportation is requesting bids for emergency removal and disposal of storm related vegetative debris of various types upon request in Madison County to be let at 2:00 PM on Monday, November 4, 2024.

The availability date for this project is **November 11, 2024.** 

The completion date for this project is **November 10, 2025.** 

## **EMERGENCY BID REQUIREMENTS**

This is an Emergency Response contract and as such, the Department has determined that it is not feasible nor in the public's interest to comply with statutory bidding requirements in obtaining equipment and/or contractors for assistance in our cleanup efforts. This is being done pursuant to the authority granted by G.S. 136-28.1 (e). As a result, the following changes apply to this contract:

Any firm that wishes to bid as a prime contractor shall be prequalified with NCDOT as a Bidder or PO Prime Contractor or have the ability to become prequalified for the work being performed within 14 days of receipt of the contract. A minimum of 3 contractors will be solicited to bid for work on this contract.

Bids shall be emailed to Chad Loftis at the following email address <u>celoftis@ncdot.gov</u> and must be time stamped in the inbox no later than 2:00 P.M. on Monday, November 4, 2024.

Firms that wish to perform work on Division Purchase Order Contracts as either the prime contractor or as a subcontractor on the project must be prequalified for the type work they wish to perform. Firms that wish to perform as a subcontractor to the prime contractor must be prequalified **prior to beginning work on the project.**
