The North Carolina Department of Transportation is requesting bids for permanent repairs to Bridge 413 over Dillingham Creek on SR-2174 (Williams Branch Rd) and Bridge 146 over Stony Fork Creek on SR-2173 (Dillingham Rd) in Buncombe County to be let at 2:00 PM on Wednesday, December 17, 2025.

The availability date for this project is **February 16, 2026.** 

The completion date for this project is May 8, 2026.

Bids for this project must be submitted electronically. Refer to the Instructions to Bidders in the proposal for more information.

Firms that wish to perform work on Division Purchase Order Contracts as either the prime contractor or as a subcontractor on the project must be prequalified for the type work they wish to perform. Firms that wish to bid on these projects as the prime contractor must be prequalified **prior to submitting your bid.** Firms that wish to perform as a subcontractor to the prime contractor must be prequalified **prior to beginning work on the project.** 

Any firm that wishes to bid as a prime contractor shall be prequalified as a Bidder or PO Prime Contractor prior to submitting a bid. Information regarding prequalification can be found at:
