1.	S1.0	See attached Bulletin Drawing SB1, for notes on saw cutting and coordinating the new footing with the existing stone wall at the existing exterior stone stairs. Approximately 2" will need to be saw cut from the corner of the stone wall to allow the new exterior wall to be built.	
2.	S1.0	Notes: Change Note 1. to read: "Concrete Strength for <u>footings = 3000</u> Change Note 4. To read: "Floor slab shall be 4" thick concrete reinf. w/ 6x6-W1.4xW1.4 WWR on Min. <u>10 MIL</u> vapor retarder over 4" compacted granular base."	
3.	A1.0	Demolition Key Notes- Add Note D-11:" Remove existing downspout (to right of Demo.Key Note D-6) and existing gutter above Demo. Key Notes D-4 and D-5."

4. A1.0 Demolition Plan 1/A1.0. Demolition Key Note D-7 applies to entire existing restroom area and corridor, with the exception of the existing Janitor Closet. 5. A1.0 Demolition Plan 1/A1.0. Demolition Key Note D-10 clarification: "Contractor to remove all finished material on the interior of exterior walls." This includes the existing wall board, as it would not necessarily survive in good condition after the demolition of the existing tile. 6. A4.1 & A4.3 Floor Tile Pattern 2/A4.1 and Floor Legend (Sheet A4.3)- All restrooms (Rooms 102,103,104, 108 & 109) will use the specified 24"x24" tile which will be cut into 12"x12" tiles, so the tile may be sloped to each floor drain. See 1/A4.1 for location of floor drain in Family Restroom 102. 7. A4.1 Detail 3/A4.1-Accent Band, the Contractor is not required to install T711 to a flush level with TS 19. 8. A4.1 Elevation Key 1/A4.1, Elevation 15/A4.2 refers to Janitor Closet 110. The shaded area on 15/A4.2 refers to Fiberglass Reinforced Plastic Wall Panel. Contractor shall field verify cove base installation to match existing. 9. A4.2 Elevation 9/A4.2- Stone Field shown in interior elevation is Existing Stone To Remain. Elevations 1/A4.2 & 2/A4.2-Cove base will be installed under the shown 10. A4.2 Cedar walls (Cedar Field) and Tile Accent 4. Cove base will match what is shown throughout the project: American Olean, Relevance, Essential Charcoal RL04 Textured-6" x 12"- S-36C9T with Grout: Quartz Lock, 380 Charcoal Gray. The design intent is for the installation of tile cove base at all walls with the exception of the existing stone veneer, interior walls of Pipe Chases 105 & 107, and Janitor 110. 11. A4.3 As noted on Sheet A4.3, Wall Legend: "Contractor is not required to install the Accent Tile 2 to a flush level with Accent 3 Tile." Daltile, Series Serenade- glass tile (accent 2) shall be run vertically and is 1/8" thickness. Adjoining Daltile, Series Fossil ridge, natural stone tile (Accent 3) and shall be run vertically and is 3/8" thickness. Contractor is not required to install the Accent 2 tile to a flush level with Accent 3 tile. The thin set for this accent should not exceed 1/8". 12. P3 1/P3 DWV Plan- Change Mark "L2" at wall hung lavatory in Family Restroom to "L1" as shown on Plumbing Fixture Schedule on Sheet P1. Change Mark "L1" at 2-station Lavatories in Mens and Womens (rooms 103,104,107 & 108) to "L2" as shown on Plumbing Fixture Schedule on

The existing Gas Furnace and Outdoor condensing unit shall be removed

Lighting Schedule: Recessed Fixtures W1 & W2 shall have aluminum trim.
 Change Fixture "D" to: "Troy C3100 Ceiling Mounted Fixture".
 Change Fixture "WS" to: "Troy B3101 Decorative Wall Sconce". (This fixture is on back order but is still being manufactured.)

2. 09300	Part 2-Products, 2.02 Tile Products A.1.a.3 24"x24"x3/8" tile will be cut into 12"x12"x3/8" tile for installation in all restrooms (Rooms 102, 103, 104, 108 & 109).
3. 09300	Part 2-Products, 2.06 Miscellaneous Materials A Add Gold Bond e2XP Tile Backer as an acceptable Backer Unit.
4. 09300	Part 3-Execution, 3.01 Installation-General B., 3.02 Tile Applications A.2.a., - Remove all references to "Tile Over Tile" installation. See Sheet A1.0, Demolition Key Note D-7: "Contractor to remove existing floor tile, & mortar bed in its entirety. Existing plywood floor shall be preserved." (There will not be any tile installed over existing tile. The only tile not demolished is in Janitor 110. Install a 2" marble threshold between its existing tile and the new tile in Men 103, as shown in Sill Detail 11/A5.1.)
5. 10170	Part 2-Products, 2.02 Panel Materials A.2.c –delete reference to changing tables.
