DN01011 Pre Bid Meeting Minutes

- Was brought up that town does not allow night work or weekend work will need to discuss with them. 730 am to 6 allowable
- The bid documents don't have a line for rock removal. Should there be a line item for this or is it to be figured in the grading price? Since there is not separate a separate line item for rock removal, it is considered part of lump sum grading.
- There is a line item for temporary traffic control. Will the road be closed while we are there working? No; the road is not to be closed. There is no offsite detour, so traffic must be maintained through the project, using lane closures and shoulder closures. Also is there a plan or detail of what the state requires for this line? No Transportation Management Plan provided for this contract. However, there are Traffic Control project special provisions that direct the contractor on how to proceed with this scope of work; you will need to reference the 2024 Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures, as well as the 2024 Roadway Standard Drawings, as directed by the provision.
- Is this a federal funded project or state funded? This clearly denoted on both the cover page of the proposal and the Invitation to Bid.
- In our last project we were told we had a DBE credit for using more than was required. How do I utilize that credit? You will need to reach out to Jorgelia Nino at jnino@ncdot.gov to determine if you have sufficient banked fund available for use. If you are the apparent low bidder, Division 14 will notify you by email to submit Letters of Intent and if the goal is not met, then we will also give you instruction to submit a Good Faith Effort or a formal request to use banked credits. The bidder will need to email d14contracts@ncdot.gov letting us know whether you are submitting a Good Faith Effort or using banked credits; this declaration must be made up front. Once declared, the bidder cannot change to the other method. For example, if banking is declared and is denied, then the bidder cannot swap back to GFE, and vice versa.
- Will there be any bank retention for this project? Banking MBE/WBE Credit is thoroughly covered on page G-12 of the proposal.
- Blasting was brought up. Blasting is covered under section 220 of Spec Book any item including monitering ECT will be incidental to Lump Sum Grading.

Environmental Items From Green Sheet

- Project will adhere to NCDOT best management practices to ensure erosion and sedimentation does not occur off-site.
- All tree removal will occur during October 15th April 1st to avoid potential effects to bat species.
- All clearing, construction and staging shall not extend past the Human Environment, area of potential effect (APE). If resources are discovered during construction, contact will be made immediately with the Division Environmental Office and the NCDOT Human Environment Unit.

- Project staging and construction will avoid the Lucile S. and Robert N. Hughs House [MA0654] due to the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) eligibility recommendation.
- A pre-construction meeting will be required with Division Environmental Staff to discuss project limits, permits and archaeological resources.
