Content Summary: Question & Answer

A bidder has posed the following questions, and the Department has provided the following responses:

Bidder Question # 1: Please specify the extent of MOT needed on this project specifically are we to install and maintain any detours or provide PCMB to notify the public that the road is closed?

Department Response # 1: The Department has a functioning detour in place. The expectation is that the Department's detour will remain in place until the roadbed has been restored to a point where it will sustain vehicular traffic. At that time, the Contractor shall be responsible for any traffic control needed for the remaining project operations, such as paving, pavement marking, etc...

Bidder Question # 2: Can the existing concrete barriers closing the road remain in place or will the contractor have to bring in their own barriers?

Department Response # 2: The Department will leave its existing concrete barriers in place for the duration of the project, however, the Contractor is to use his Type III Barricades, so that the Department can collect theirs.

Bidder Question # 3: How far below the existing roadway should we assume we are going to start installing Micropiles/Soil Nails?

Department Response # 3: The Contractor's surveyor is to establish that information, after they have conducted their site investigation.

These revisions do not change bid items or the associated quantities.
