The above contract has experienced the following revisions:

- 1. The bid items have been revised to include the quantities. (See attached)
- 2. The following are concerns / questions, posed by a bidder, and the corresponding answers / responses:
 - a. **Concern #1:** It shows in the proposal that the markings are to be regular thermoplastic. Generally spray thermoplastic is used when applying over rumble strips due to its ability to adhere to the curved surfaces more evenly. Traditional thermoplastic installed at 90 mils will tend to puddle in the bottom of the rumble strip because it takes much longer for it to cool and harden. The spray thermoplastic contains more resin and adheres better to the uneven surface and dries quickly which minimizes the puddling tendencies of the thicker extruded/ribbon type thermoplastic.

Response #1: NCDOT acknowledges the bidder's concern and subsequent suggestions, but due to poor longevity and degradation issues on previous uses of spray thermo, under this application, it chooses to opt for 90 mil thermo.

b. **Concern #2:** I was also hoping to get some clarification regarding the placement of the markings where edge rumbles are installed. Will the markings be placed in the edge of the rumble or are these rumbles on the

shoulder?

Response 2: Placement will be based on the field conditions for each corridor and whether there is enough shoulder. Typically, our two-lane corridors do not have adequate space to put separation between the edge line and rumble strips.

c. **Question #1:** Will this project be available to bid via BidExpress?
