This project involves the installation of approximately 500 square yards of concrete sidewalks, 225 square yards of concrete driveways, 16 curb ramps, and one modular block retaining wall. This project is funded through the North Carolina Department of Transportation and requires compliance with contract, payment and construction guidelines.

Bids must be enclosed in a sealed envelope, addressed to the City of New Bern, PO Box 1129, New Bern, NC 28563. The outside of the envelope must be marked "Bid for NEUSE BOULEVARD SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS-PHASE I". All bids must be made on blank forms provided and included in the bound document. The name, address, and license number of the Bidder must be plainly marked thereon.

Each Bid must be accompanied by cash or a certified check, drawn on a bank or trust company authorized to do business in North Carolina, payable to the City of New Bern in an amount at least equal to five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid, as a guarantee that a contract will be entered into. In lieu of cash or certified check, the Bidder may submit a bid bond in the form prescribed in G.S. 143-129 as amended by Chapter 1104 of the Public Laws of 1951.

Contractors are notified that legislative acts relating to licensing of contractors will be observed in receiving and awarding contracts.
