The Bidder has carefully examined the location of the proposed work to be known as Contract No. 11431164; has carefully examined the plans and specifications, which are acknowledged to be part of the proposal, the special provisions, the proposal, the form of contract, and the forms of contract payment bond and contract performance bond; and thoroughly understands the stipulations, requirements and provisions. The undersigned bidder agrees to bound upon his execution of the bid and subsequent award to him by the Board of Transportation in accordance with this proposal to provide the necessary contract payment bond and contract performance bond within fourteen days after the written notice of award is received by him. The undersigned Bidder further agrees to provide all necessary machinery, tools, labor, and other means of construction; and to do all the work and to furnish all materials, except as otherwise noted, necessary to perform and complete the said contract in accordance with the 2012 Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures by the dates(s) specified in the Project Special Provisions and in accordance with the requirements of the Engineer, and at the unit or lump sum prices, as the case may be, for the various items given on the sheets contained herein.

The Bidder shall provide and furnish all the materials, machinery, implements, appliances and tools, and perform the work and required labor to construct and complete State Highway Contract No. <u>11431164</u> in <u>Beaufort County</u>, for the unit or lump sum prices, as the case may be, bid by the Bidder in his bid and according to the proposal, plans, and specifications prepared by said Department, which proposal, plans, and specifications show the details covering this project, and hereby become a part of this contract.

The published volume entitled *North Carolina Department of Transportation, Raleigh, Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures, January 2012* with all amendments and supplements thereto, is by reference incorporated into and made a part of this contract; that, except as herein modified, all the construction and work included in this contract is to be done in accordance with the specifications contained in said volume, and amendments and supplements thereto, under the direction of the Engineer.

If the proposal is accepted and the award is made, the contract is valid only when signed either by the Contract Officer or such other person as may be designated by the Secretary to sign for the Department of Transportation. The conditions and provisions herein cannot be changed except over the signature of the said Contract Officer.

The quantities shown in the itemized proposal for the project are considered to be approximate only and are given as the basis for comparison of bids. The Department of Transportation may increase or decrease the quantity of any item or portion of the work as may be deemed necessary or expedient.

An increase or decrease in the quantity of an item will not be regarded as sufficient ground for an increase or decrease in the unit prices, nor in the time allowed for the completion of the work, except as provided for the contract.

A bid bond is not required for this Contract.

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### INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

# PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE PREPARING AND SUBMITTING YOUR BID.

All bids shall be prepared and submitted in accordance with the following requirements. Failure to comply with any requirement shall cause the bid to be considered irregular and shall be grounds for rejection of the bid.

- 1. The bid sheet furnished by NCDOT with the proposal shall be used and shall not be altered in any manner. DO NOT SEPARATE THE BID SHEET FROM THE PROPOSAL!
- 2. All entries on the bid sheet, including signatures, shall be written in ink.
- 1. 3. The Bidder shall submit a unit price for every item on the bid form. The unit prices for the various contract items shall be written in figures. . \*\*\*Unit Prices shall be rounded off by the bidder to contain no more than FOUR decimal places.\*\*\*
- **4.** An amount bid shall be entered on the bid sheet for every item. The amount bid for each item shall be determined by multiplying each unit bid by the quantity for that item, and shall be written in figures in the "Amount Bid" column of the sheet.
- **5.** The total amount bid shall be written in figures in the proper place on the bid sheet. The total amount shall be determined by adding the amounts bid for each item.
- **6.** Changes in any entry shall be made by marking through the entry in ink and making the correct entry adjacent thereto in ink. A representative of the Bidder shall initial the change in ink.

### AWARD OF CONTRACT

The award of the contract, if it be awarded, will be made to the lowest responsible bidder in accordance with Section 102 (excluding 102-10) of the Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures, 2012. The lowest responsible bidder will be notified that his bid has been accepted and that he has been awarded the contract. NCDOT reserves the right to reject all bids.

# PROJECT SPECIAL PROVISIONS GENERAL

### **DESCRIPTION:**

This contract is for the removal and proper disposal of dead animals and Trash from litter pickup from various state system routes in Beaufort County. The Engineer will notify the contractor of each dead animal or Trash location throughout the life of the contract.

All work and materials shall be in accordance with the provisions of the General Guidelines of this contract, the Project Special Provisions, the North Carolina Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures 2012, the North Carolina Department of Transportation 2012 Roadway Standards Drawings, and the current edition of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), with the exception that bid bonds are *not* required.

### The quantities stated in the Bid Form are estimates and are not guaranteed.

The Contractor shall keep himself fully informed of all Federal, State and local laws, ordinances, and regulations, and shall comply with the provisions of Section 107 of the <u>Standard Specifications</u>.

This contract shall be bid by certified small business contractors only.

### MANDATORY PRE-BID CONFERENCE:

In order to bid on this contract, all prospective bidders must attend the Pre-Bid Conference to be held on Tuesday November 4, 2014 at 10:00 AM at the NCDOT Beaufort County Maintineance Yard, located at 803 Grimes Rd, Washington, NC 28504. This meeting will begin promptly at 10:00 AM. Prospective bidders arriving after the 10:00 AM starting time will not be allowed to bid. The Conference will be conducted by Department personnel for the purpose of providing additional information about the project and to give all bidders an opportunity to ask any questions they may have. Only bids received from the bidders who have attended and properly registered at the Pre-Bid Conference will be considered.

Attendance at the Pre-Bid Conference will not meet the requirements of proper registration unless the individual attending has registered with the following information:

- 1. The individual writes his/her name on the official roster.
- 2. The individual writes in the name and address of the company he/she represents.
- 3. Only one company is shown as being represented by the individual attending.

The individual is an officer or permanent employee of the firm they represent.

### **CONTRACT TIME AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:**

The date of availability for this project is December 1, 2014. The Contractor may begin work prior to this date upon approval of the Engineer or his duly authorized representative. If such approval is given, and the Contractor begins work prior to the date of availability, the Department of Transportation will assume no responsibility for any delays caused prior to the date of availability by any reason whatsoever, and such delays, if any, will not constitute a valid reason for extending the completion date.

No work will be permitted and no purchase order will be issued until all required bonds and prerequisite conditions and certifications have been satisfied.

The completion date for this project is November 30, 2015 or at the limit of \$500,000 dollars. The Contractor shall submit his bid for one year.

### **TERM OF THE CONTRACT:**

The Contractor shall submit his bid for one year. At the option of the Department, this contract may be extended for two (2) additional periods of one (1) year each (maximum) three year total). The year for the renewal periods shall begin December 1 and end November 30 of the following year. The unit bid prices will be increased by three (3) percent for each one year extension. No changes in the terms, conditions, etc. of this contract will be made when an extension to the contract is implemented. The Engineer will notify the Contractor in writing by November 1 if the contract may be extended. The Contractor must notify the Engineer in writing by November 15 of his acceptance or rejection of this offer. Failure on the part of the Contractor to reply will be received as a rejection of contract extension.

### **AUTHORITY OF THE ENGINEER:**

The Engineer for this project shall be the Division Engineer, Division 2, Division of Highways, North Carolina Department of Transportation, acting directly or through his duly authorized representatives.

The Engineer will decide all questions which may arise as to the quality and acceptability of work performed and as to the rate of progress of the work; all questions which may arise as to the interpretation of the contract; and all questions as to the acceptable fulfillment of the contract on the part of the Contractor. His decision shall be final and he shall have executive authority to enforce and make effective such decisions and orders as the Contractor fails to carry out promptly.

### **NOTIFICATION OF WORK:**

The NCDOT will notify the Contractor of each location on the state highway system where a dead animal or trash is to be picked up. Notification will be done by fax, phone, or email. The Contractor will have until the end of the calendar day following the day of notification to remove the dead animal or Trash. The Contractor will be charged Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each item not removed by the end of the calendar day following the day of notification.

If the Engineer notifies the Contractor for an emergency response pick up, the Contractor will have 2 hours following the notification to remove the dead animal or trash. If the 2 hour response time is not met, the Contractor will be charged One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per hour for <u>each hour</u> over the 2 hours following notification. The Engineer will notify the Contractor only during working hours of Monday – Friday, 7:30 am – 4:30 pm.

The contractor shall only pick up dead animals or trash as directed by the Engineer.

### PROSECUTION AND PROGRESS:

The Contractor shall pursue the work diligently with workmen in sufficient numbers, abilities, and supervision, and with equipment, materials, and methods of construction as may be required to complete the work described in the contract by the completion date and in accordance with Section 108 of the <u>Standard Specifications</u>

The Contractor's vehicles and equipment shall not be parked within the State Highway System right of way overnight or at other times when work has been suspended unless approved by the Engineer, and in no case within 30 feet of the edge of pavement. The Engineer may designate specific locations for parking equipment.

The Contractor shall furnish the applicable certifications and documentation for all materials as required by the <u>Standard Specifications</u>. Material which is not properly certified will not be accepted.

### TRAFFIC CONTROL AND WORK ZONE SAFETY:

All traffic control shall be done in accordance with the latest edition of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) and NCDOT policies. All personnel when working in traffic areas or areas in close proximity to traffic shall wear an approved safety vest, or shirt or jacket which meets the color requirements of the MUTCD.

The Contractor shall comply with all applicable Federal, State, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations governing safety, health, and sanitation, and shall provide all safeguards, safety devices, and protective equipment, and shall take any other needed actions, on his own responsibility that are reasonably necessary to protect the life and health of employees on the job and the safety of the public, and to protect property in connection with the performance of the work covered by the contract.

Failure to comply with any of the requirements for safety and traffic control of this contract shall result in suspension of work as provided in subarticle 108-7(2) of the Standard Specifications.

### **SAFETY VESTS:**

All Contractors' personnel, all subcontractors and their personnel, and any material suppliers and their personnel must wear an OSHA approved reflective vest or outer garment at all times while on the project.

### **SUPERVISION BY CONTRACTOR:**

At all times during the life of the project the Contractor shall provide one permanent employee who shall have the authority and capability for overall responsibility of the project and who shall be personally available at the work site within 24 hours notice. Such employee shall be fully authorized to conduct all business with the subcontractors, to negotiate and execute all supplemental agreements, and to execute the orders or directions of the Engineer.

At all times that work is actually being performed, the Contractor shall have present on the project one competent individual who is authorized to act in a supervisory capacity over all work on the project, including work subcontracted. The individual who has been so authorized shall be experienced in the type of work being performed and shall be fully capable of managing, directing, and coordinating the work; of reading and thoroughly understanding the contract; and receiving and

carrying out directions from the Engineer or his authorized representatives. He shall be an employee of the Contractor unless otherwise approved by the Engineer.

The Contractor may, at his option, designate one employee to meet the requirements of both positions. However, whenever the designated employee is absent from the work site, an authorized individual qualified to act in a supervisory capacity on the project shall be present.

### **LIABILITY INSURANCE:**

# Page 1-68, Article 107-16 is amended to include the following as the first, second, third and fourth paragraphs:

The Contractor shall be liable for any losses resulting from a breach of the terms of this contract. The Contractor shall be liable for any losses due to the negligence or willful misconduct of its agents, assigns and employees including any sub-contractors which causes damage to others for which the Department is found liable under the Torts Claims Act, or in the General Courts of Justice, provided the Department provides prompt notice to the Contractor and that the Contractor has an opportunity to defend against such claims. The Contractor shall not be responsible for punitive damages.

The Contractor shall at its sole cost and expense obtain and furnish to the Department an original standard ACORD form certificate of insurance evidencing commercial general liability with a limit for bodily injury and property damage in the amount of \$5,000,000.00 per occurrence and general aggregate, covering the Contractor from claims or damages for bodily injury, personal injury, or for property damages which may arise from operating under the contract by the employees and agents of the Contractor. The required limit of insurance may be obtained by a single general liability policy or the combination of a general liability and excess liability or umbrella policy. The State of North Carolina shall be named as an additional insured on this commercial general liability policy. The policy may contain the following language as relates to the State as an additional insured: "This insurance with respect to the additional insured applies only to the extent that the additional insured is held liable for your or your agent's acts or omissions arising out of and in the course of operations performed for the additional insured."

The Contractor shall maintain all legally required insurance coverage, including without limitation, worker's compensation and vehicle liability, in the amounts required by law. Providing and maintaining adequate insurance coverage is a material obligation of the contractor and is of the essence of this contract. All such insurance shall meet all laws of the State of North Carolina. Such insurance coverage shall be obtained from companies that are authorized to provide such coverage and that are authorized by the Commissioner of Insurance to do business in North Carolina. The Contractor shall at all times comply with the terms of such insurance policies.

Upon execution of the contract, provide evidence of the above insurance requirements to the Engineer.

### **CONTRACT PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE BOND:**

Due to the nature of this project, no performance or payments bonds will be required.

### **WORKER'S COMPENSATION COVERAGE:**

Pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 97-19, all contractors of the Department of Transportation are required, prior to beginning services, to show proof of coverage issued by a workers' compensation insurance carrier, or a certificate of compliance issued by the Department of Insurance for self-insured subcontractors stating that it has complied with N.C.G.S. § 97-93 irrespective of whether subcontractors have regularly in service fewer than three employees in the same business within the State of North Carolina, and subcontractors shall be hereinafter liable under the Workers' Compensation Act for payment of compensation and other benefits to its employees for any injury or death due to an accident arising out of and in the course of performance of the work insured by the subcontractor.

### **SUBLETTING OF CONTRACT:**

The Contractor shall not sublet, sell, transfer, assign or otherwise dispose of this contract or any portion thereof; or his right, title, or interest therein; without written consent of the Engineer. Subletting of this contract or any portion of the contract shall conform to the requirements of Article of 108-6 of the Standard Specifications

### **DEFAULT OF CONTRACT:**

The Department of Transportation shall have the right to declare a default of contract for breach by the Contractor of any material term or condition of the contract. Default of contract shall be in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures of Article 108-9 of the <u>Standard Specifications</u>.

### **BANKRUPTCY:**

The Department of Transportation, at its option, may terminate the contract upon filing by the Contractor of any petition for protection under the provisions of the Federal Bankruptcy Act.

### CLAIMS FOR ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION OR EXTENSION OF TIME:

Any claims for additional compensation and/or extensions of the completion date shall be submitted to the Division Engineer in writing, with detailed justification, **prior** to submitting the final invoice payment. Once an invoice is received and accepted that is marked as "Final", the Contractor shall be barred from recovery.

### **DEBARMENT STATEMENT:**

The Contractor certifies and understands that by his/her signature on the Bid Form that he/she and the contracting firm he/she represents has not been banned, debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, or declared ineligible for the award of contracts by any Federal agency.

### PROMPT PAYMENT:

# <u>Prompt Payment of Monies Due Subcontractors, Second Tier Subcontractors and Material</u> Suppliers

Contractors at all levels, prime, subcontractor, or second tier contractor, shall within seven calendar days of receipt of monies, resulting from work performed on the project or services rendered, pay subcontractors, second tier subcontractors, or material suppliers, as appropriate. This seven-day period begins upon knowledgeable receipt by the contracting firm obligated to make a subsequent periodic payment or final payment. These prompt payment requirements will be met if each firm mails the payment to the next level firm by evidence of postmark within the seven-day period.

This provision for prompt payment shall be incorporated into each subcontract or second tier subcontract issued for work performed on the project or for services provided. Failure of any entity to make prompt payment as defined herein may result in (1) withholding of money due to that entity in the next partial payment until such assurances are made satisfactory to this provision; or (2) removal of an approved contractor from the pre-qualified bidders list or the removal of other entities from the approved subcontractors list.

### **PAYMENT AND RETAINAGE:**

The Contractor may submit requests for partial payments on a monthly basis, or other interval as approved by the Engineer. Compensation for all pay items shall be in accordance with the <u>Standard Specifications</u>. The amount of partial payments will be based on the work accomplished and accepted by the last day of the approved pay period.

Upon satisfactory completion of the work and acceptance by the Department, the contractor shall submit invoices in triplicate for each job site according to materials used. All invoices shall have a separate invoice number and include the Requisition and Purchase Order Number of the appropriate contract. All invoice items and unit costs shall correspond to contract pay items. In the event of error or discrepancy in items or unit costs, the Department may return the invoice to the contractor for correction. The invoice shall be completely and legibly filled out with all appropriate information and shall be signed by an authorized representative of the Contractor.

All requests for payment shall be submitted to the **Beaufort** County Maintenance Engineer's office.

Due to the nature of the contract, no retainage will be withheld. However, the Department reserves the right to withhold payment for a specific location until after successful completion of the work as verified by the final inspection of that location.

### **GIFTS FROM VENDORS AND CONTRACTORS:**

(12-15-09) 107-1 SPI G152

By Executive Order 24, issued by Governor Perdue, and *N.C.G.S.*§ 133-32, it is unlawful for any vendor or contractor (i.e. architect, bidder, contractor, construction manager, design professional, engineer, landlord, offeror, seller, subcontractor, supplier, or vendor), to make gifts or to give favors to any State employee of the Governor's Cabinet Agencies (i.e. Administration, Commerce, Correction, Crime Control and Public Safety, Cultural Resources, Environment and Natural Resources, Health and Human Services, Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, Revenue, Transportation, and the Office of the Governor). This prohibition covers those vendors and contractors who:

- (A) Have a contract with a governmental agency; or
- (B) Have performed under such a contract within the past year; or
- (C) Anticipate bidding on such a contract in the future.

For additional information regarding the specific requirements and exemptions, vendors and contractors are encouraged to review Executive Order 24 and *N.C.G.S.* § 133-32.

Executive Order 24 also encouraged and invited other State Agencies to implement the requirements and prohibitions of the Executive Order to their agencies. Vendors and contractors should contact other State Agencies to determine if those agencies have adopted Executive Order 24.

**EMPLOYMENT:** 

(11-15-11) (Rev. 1-17-12) 108, 102 SPI G184

Revise the 2012 Standard Specifications as follows:

Page 1-20, Subarticle 102-15(O), delete and replace with the following:

(O) Failure to restrict a former Department employee as prohibited by Article 108-5.

Page 1-65, Article 108-5 Character of Workmen, Methods, and Equipment, line 32, delete all of line 32, the first sentence of the second paragraph and the first word of the second sentence of the second paragraph.

### **STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATOR TITLE CHANGE:**

(9-18-12) SPI G185

Revise the 2012 Standard Specifications as follows:

Replace all references to "State Highway Administrator" with "Chief Engineer".

### PROJECT SPECIAL PROVISIONS

### DEAD ANIMAL REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL:

The Division of Highways is responsible for the removal and proper disposal of any and all dead animals found on the state's highways. Animals can be domestic or wild and can range in size from a cat to a bear.

The work covered by this provision consists of the removal and disposal of all types of dead animals from within the right of way limits of the state highway system in **Beaufort County**. Domestic dead animals that have a collar must be picked up also; the Contractor will record the information off of the tags on the collar and give to the Department. The number of dead animals indicated on the bid form is an estimate for bidding purposes only and is intended to cover an entire calendar year. The actual amount may be higher or lower.

In order to account for all dead animals disposed of, the Contractor shall photograph each dead animal on site. The Contractor shall submit the photographs to the Department either by hard copy or on CD. The Contractor may also submit photographs to the Department on a flash drive, the Contractor may pick up the flash drive the following business day. Each photograph shall be numbered to correspond the order in which the dead animals were picked up, also the date and time shall be listed on the photograph. One photograph shall be taken at approximately 5 to 10 feet from the carcass to identify the animal. A second photograph shall be taken from 50 to 100 feet from the carcass to identify the location. Both photographs shall include the carcass. **The photographs must accompany all invoices (see Basis of Payment).** 

The Contractor shall fill out a log sheet for each day's work. The log sheet will show the number of the dead animal that will correspond with the photograph, date and time dead animal was picked up, the location of the dead animal, and the type of dead animal. The log sheet shall be turned in to the Department the following business day. The logs must include photographs of the carcasses. The Contractor will be charged one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per day late fee for logs received after the following business day. The Department will provide the log sheets.

All animals must be disposed of according to local laws and ordinances. It is the responsibility of the Contractor to be aware of all requirements for disposal of dead animals in **Beaufort County**.

### TRASH REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL:

The Division of Highways is responsible for the removal and proper disposal of trash following a litter pick up as well as the removal and proper disposal of large roadside debris. These items can range in size from trash bags to household furniture.

The work covered by this provision consists of the removal and disposal of all types of trash from within the right of way limits of the state highway system in **Beaufort County**. The number of trash items indicated on the bid form is an estimate for bidding purposes only and is intended to cover an entire calendar year. The actual amount may be higher or lower.

In order to account for all trash items disposed of, the Contractor shall photograph each truck load. The Contractor shall submit the photographs to the Department either by hard copy or on CD. The Contractor may also submit photographs to the Department on a flash drive, the Contractor may pick up the flash drive the following business day. Each photograph shall be numbered to correspond the order in which the trash was picked up; also the date and time shall be listed on the photograph. The photograph shall show the contents of the truck bed in one photograph. The photographs must accompany all invoices (see Basis of Payment).

The Contractor shall fill out a log sheet for each day's work. The log sheet will show the number that will correspond with the photograph, date and time the trash was picked up, the location of the trash, the number of trash bags picked up, and the number of other large roadside debris picked up with a description of the item(s). The log sheet shall be turned in to the Department the following business day. The logs must include photographs. The Contractor will be charged one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per day late fee for logs received after the following business day. The Department will provide the log sheets.

All trash must be disposed of according to local laws and ordinances. Roadside debris can be deposited at the landfill with no tipping fee. The Engineer will provide the Contractor with identification to be used at the landfill for this purpose.

### **BASIS OF PAYMENT:**

The quantity of **Dead Animal Removal and Disposal** to be paid for will be the actual number of dead animals removed and disposed from the highway. A separate line item will be used for **Site Visit – No Dead Animal** where an animal cannot be found. The quantity of **Trash Removal and Disposal** will be paid for as the actual number of bags and/or items removed and disposed of from the highway. A separate line item will be used for **Emergency Response** and will paid for as the actual number of emergency site visits and will be in addition to the dead animal or trash removal item(s). **Only the dead animals or trash that have been faxed, phoned, or emailed to the Contractor by the Engineer or his representative will be counted. The quantity of trash removed and disposed, measured as provided above, will be paid for at the contract unit price per each item under "Trash Removal and Disposal". ### **INSPECTION:**
