## NOTICE TO PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS

Subject: Invitation to Bid

- *Project Description:* Installation of Median & Shoulder Guardrail on US 74 & US 421 in New Hanover County
- WBS Element #: 45333.3.1 and 43290.3.1

The North Carolina Department of Transportation is requesting bids for Installing 8726 LF of Steel BM Guardrail, 4850 Steel BM Guardrail (Double Faced), etc. along Us 74 (MLK Parkway) and US 421 (Lake Park Blvd. / Carolina Beach Road). All quantities are estimates only. The Contractor is to furnish labor, material, equipment, and traffic control.

The availability date for this project is May 21, 2012. There is an ICT for Map# 2 by June 22, 2012. The completion date is August 17, 2012.

Sealed bids must be received in the Division 3 Engineer's Office at 5501 Barbados Blvd., Castle Hayne, North Carolina 28429 by 2:00 PM on Thursday, April 19, 2012. Bids must be submitted on the official bid sheet included in the proposal and display the following statement on the front of the envelope:

QUOTATION FOR WBS ELEMENT # 45333.3.1 and 43290.3.1: Installation of Median and Shoulder Guardrail on US 47 & US 421 in New Hanover County. To Be Opened at 2:00pm on Thursday, April 19, 2012

Beginning July 1, 2009, any firm that wishes to perform work on Division Purchase Order Contracts as either the prime contractor or as a subcontractor on the project must be prequalified for the type of work they wish to perform. Firms that wish to bid on these projects as the prime contractor must be prequalified <u>prior to submitting a bid</u>. Firms that wish to perform as a subcontractor to the prime contractor must be prequalified <u>prior to beginning work on the project</u>.

For the purposes of prequalification, any firm that is currently prequalified as a prime or a subcontractor on central let projects for the appropriate work codes is considered eligible to work and/or bid on Purchase Order Contracts as long as other items such as bonding and license requirements for the contract are met.
