NOTICE TO PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS

Subject: Invitation to Bid on Division Contract

The North Carolina Department of Transportation is requesting bids for **PAVEMENT REHABILITATION** work located on **I-95 FROM MILEMARKER 102 TO MILEMARKER 105** in **JOHNSTON COUNTY**.

Any firm that wishes to perform work on Division Purchase Order Contracts as either the prime contractor or as a subcontractor on the project must be prequalified for the type of work they wish to perform. Firms that wish to bid on these projects as the prime contractor must be prequalified as a Bidder or PO Prime Contractor <u>prior to submitting your bid</u>. Firms that wish to perform as a subcontractor to the prime contractor must be prequalified <u>prior to beginning work on the project</u>. Due to the unexpected nature of this work, the standard 14 day advertisement period has been shortened to 7 days. Sealed Bids must be received in the Division Office at 509 Ward Blvd., Wilson, NC 27893 by **2:00 PM** on **Thursday, March 23, 2017**. Bids must be submitted on the official bid sheet included in the proposal and display the following statement on the front of the envelope:

A Bid Bond is required in accordance with Article 102-10 of the 2012 Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures.

Contract Payment and Performance Bonds are required in accordance with Article 103-7 of the 2012 Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures with the exception of the following modification:

The successful bidder shall provide the required Payment and Performance Bonds within 7 calendar days after the notice of award is received.

Electronic Bid Preparation with Manual Delivery is also acceptable. If you wish to submit your bid in this manner, please download the EBS file and the NC_DBE file. Please submit a CD or USB flash drive of your electronic bid along with a printed, signed copy of your bid attached to the proposal.

Do NOT submit bids for projects let by Division 4 to the NCDOT Statewide Project Letting Office.
