General Comments from Pre-Bid Meeting

- Overview of current project was discussed along with plan review and emphasis areas of the bid document.
- Pre-bid sign-up sheet attached. Revised Bid form attached which should replace original.
- Owner representative is responsible for sampling and testing of materials incorporated in the project for final acceptance.
- Date of availability of contract will be the NTP date (approximately July 2023).
- Reference points for staking will be provided by owner representative.

Questions from Pre-Bid meeting and email inquiries

- There is no item in bid schedule for undercut and backfill on this project. On the detail sheet 3-C5.1 for asphalt paving there is notes pertaining undercut and backfill and use of fabric and that Geotech engineer will make decision in using? The site of Wayne Industrial park in pass has had serious unsuitable soils issues. Should we have established a pay item made for undercut and backfill? If not, how do you pay for undercut and backfill? Yes, separate pay items added to revise bid form as a contingency item.
- Also detail 5-C5.1 shows driveway apron (valley gutter) We do not have a pay item set up for. Should we have an item set up for concrete driveway? 6" Driveway item added to revise bid form.
- Waterline construction shown by others but no construction for Harry Ivey Drive appears to commence prior to Ivey Drive project. Items for 8" Waterline has been added to the revised bid form and corrected on the plans.
- Plans show 18" Sanitary Sewer line but bid form has 12" noted. Correction to item on revise bid form.

- Typical section shows curb and gutter on subgrade. Should there be asphalt or ABC stone under curb? No base material required under the curb and gutter. No change to the typical section
- For the two encasement pipe runs, are we to install just the encasement or to include the carrier pipes as well? (24" enc for 12" DIP water and 36" enc for 18" DIP sewer)

This amount is agreed upon as the proper measure of liquidated damages the Owner will sustain, per day, by the failure of the Bidder to complete the work within the stipulated time, and it is not to be construed in any sense as a penalty.

The Bidder shall not have or bring a claim against the Owner, or raise as a defense against the imposition of liquidated damages, other construction purportedly impeding Bidder's progress or timely project completion.
