Report of Water Well Testing

Dear Ms. Gilchrist,

Stewart has completed water testing for the water well located at 612 Old Battle Bridge Road in Wendell, NC. The sample was collected by Stewart from an outdoor water spigot located on the outside of the primary dwelling at the subject site. Approximately 3.5 liters of water was collected into sanitized bottles after approximately 5 gallons of water was run through the spigot. The collected sample was submitted to Pace Analytical Laboratories and was tested for total suspended solids (TSS), total dissolved solids (TDS), and turbidity. The results of the laboratory testing are shown in the attached documents. These laboratory results will serve as a baseline reading for the well. 


