The North Carolina Department of Transportation is requesting bids for the following projects in Division 5:

 DE00097 – W-5205J, Intersection Improvements at SR 2558 (Guy Rd) and US 70 Business in Wake County and W-5205P, Ramp Widening and Intersection Improvements at SR 2000 (Wake Forest Rd) and WB I-440 Ramp WBS Element: 45335.3.FD10 and 45335.3.FD16 Date of Availability: August 18, 2014; Completion Date: November 21, 2014 DBE (5%)

Any firm that wishes to perform work on Division Purchase Order Contracts as either the prime contractor or as a subcontractor on the project must be prequalified for the type of work they wish to perform. Firms that wish to bid on these projects as the prime contractor must be prequalified <u>prior to</u> <u>submitting your bid</u>. Firms that wish to perform as a subcontractor to the prime contractor must be prequalified <u>prior to</u> beginning work on the project.

Any firm that wishes to bid as a prime contractor shall be prequalified as a Bidder or PO Prime Contractor prior to submitting a bid. Information regarding prequalification can be found at: https://connect.ncdot.gov/business/Prequal/Pages/default.aspx.

If you are unsure as to whether your firm is currently prequalified by the Department by the Contractual Services Unit, a search of the Directory of Transportation Firms can be performed at the website below: https://apps.dot.state.nc.us/vendor/directory/

In order to receive due consideration, your quotation must be submitted on the Bid Proposal Form and the entire proposal must be received in this office no later than:

2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 23, 2014.

Bid packages are available at <u>https://connect.ncdot.gov/letting/Pages/Letting-List.aspx?let_type=5</u>. The proposal shall be printed, stapled and returned in its entirety at the bid opening. Paper packages are available, if needed, in the Division Engineer's Office located at 2612 North Duke Street in Durham, North Carolina. Interested bidders should pick up bid packages at this location or they will be mailed upon request by contacting me or my staff at (919) 220-4600.

"Electronic" bidding is acceptable. If you wish to submit your bid electronically, please download the EBS file and the DBE file. Division 5 cannot accept online bids, please submit a CD of your electronic bid along with a printed, signed copy of your bid attached to the proposal.

Do NOT submit bids for the project let by Division 5 to the NCDOT Statewide Project Letting Office.
