A **mandatory** Pre-Bid Conference was held at 1:00 p.m. on Monday October 31, 2016 at the Division Roadside Environmental Engineer Office, 200 Roscoe Trail, Raleigh N.C. 27607. The sign in sheet is attached showing people in attendance. Also attached is a Litter-Recycables Handout.

The meeting opened with introductions by Mr. Jason Holmes and a review of the proposal.

Special attention was drawn to the following items:

Jason noted that a new Litter/Debris Removal and Recycling Report is to be filled out daily and submitted monthly. This report is to document how many lbs. were disposed and recycled from each route.

Jason emphasized that the disposal of litter must be done in an approved facility and the dump tickets must be submitted monthly with invoices.

Clarification was given as to what a Corridor Mile represented. It was explained that it was from Control of Access Fence to Control of Access Fence. This includes all shoulders and median.

Special emphasis was given to the fact that each route is to be completed in its entirety before jumping to other routes. This insures that inspection will be successful.

It shall be noted that on the bottom of page 29 where it states "Additional Clean Up Median, Toll Facilities", it should read "Additional Clean Up Median, Non-Toll Facilities".



In addition to what was discussed at the Prebid Meeting, the Division would like to reiterate that Firms that wish to bid on this project must meet the pre-qualification requirements as stated on page 5 of the proposal.
